## NOTIFICATION

No.A. 12018/1/2003-P&AR(GSW), the 15th April, 2004. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Gauge Reader under Power and Electricity Department, Government of Mizoram namely :-

1.

Short title and commencement.

Application.

Number of posts, classification and cale of pay.

Method of recruitment, and other qualifications.

- These Rules may be called the Mizoram Power & Electricity Department (Group 'D') Recruitment Rules, 2004.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. The Rules shall apply to the post specified in column-1 of the First Schedule.

3. The number of the said post (s) their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the First Schedule.

4. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts, shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the First Schedule : Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes/Schedule Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

Disqualification.	5.	<ul> <li>No person -</li> <li>(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, OR</li> <li>(b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :</li> </ul>
		Provided that, the Governor may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.
Training and Departmental Examination.	6.	Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed form time to time.
Power to transfer.	7.	Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest have the right and power to transfer any Officer or Official, recruited in accor- dance with these Rules to the post/posts/serviceas specified in First Schedule to these rules or to any other post or posi- tion which is equivalent in rank or grade.
Power to relax.	8.	Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Com- mittee/Departmental Promotion Committee through the De partment of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, relax any or the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

9. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other con cessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram as the case may be from time to time in this regard.
