## NOTIFICATION

NO.B. 11015/1/2000-L&E/Pt, the 10th May, 2004. In exercise of the power conferred under Section 5(1)(a) of the Minimum wages Act, 1948, the Jovernor of Mizoram is pleased to re-constitute a State Level Committee on Minimum wages to review Minimum Wages and advise Government of Mizoram in respect of the re-fixation of Minimum rates of wages for persons working under any scheduled/casual employments within the State of Mizoram consisting of the following members :-

2. The terms of reference of the committee will be as follows :-

1) It will review the prevailing rates of wages of persons engaged of seneduled/casual enployment coasidering prices falls in Local Market etc.

- 2) It will submit its proposals to the Govt. of Mizoram for refixation of Minimum wages of persons employed under any scheduled employment at interval of at least every 2(two) years.
- 3) It may recommend suitable enforcement machinery.
- 4) The terms of Office of the Committee shall be for a period of 2(two) years with effect from 1.6.2004 up to 31.5.2006.
- 5) Non-Official members of the Committee will be entitled to T.A. and D.A. like Group 'A' Officers of the Government.

5. The Committee will submit its reports/advise to the Government of Mizoram within 3 (three) months from its first sitting to consider revision of existing Minimum Wages by Government.
