## THE ELECTRICITY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2003.

#### AN ACT

## n j

to amend the Electricity Act, 2003.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:----

I. (I) This Act may by called the Electricity (Amend-Sment) Act, 2003.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

Power of Appellate "121. The Appellate Tribunal may, after hearing" the Appropri te Commission or other interested party, if ny, from time to time, issue such orders, instructions or directions as it may deem fit, to any Appropri te Commission for the performance of its statutory functions under this Act.".
