NOTIFICATION

No.C.11011/1/93-EDN(HTE), the 24th May, 2004. In exercise of the powers conferred under proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make rules as follows, with a view to simplify the written examination procedures for selection of candidates for higher technical courses, namely:—

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

- (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram (Selection of Candidates for Higher Technical Courses) (Third Amendment) Rules, 2004.
- (2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. AMENDMENT OF RULE 2:

In the Mizoram (Selection of candidates for Higher Technical Courses) Rules, 1999 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules) in sub-rule (1) of rule 2, the word "and English" shall be deleted.

3. Amendment of Rule 7:

In the Principal Rules -

- (a) the figure and words

 "(4) English 100 marks" appearing in both of the Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics Group and also the Physics, Chemistry and Biology Group in sub-rule (1) and
- (b) in sub-rule (2), for the words

"and English" appearing at the first line thereof shall be deleted.

4. AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE-A:

In the Principal Rules, for paragraph 2, the following paragraph shall be substituted, namely—

- (a) For Physics, Chemistry and Biology Group,-
 - (i) Physics, Chemistry Biology (Zoology and Botany)-for Agriculture and Medical etc. disciplines; and
- (b) For Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics Group,— Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (for Engineering disciplines etc)
 - (ii) Duration 11/2hours
 - (ii) Each paper shall carry 100 marks
 - (iv) All questions shall be of objective type.
