## THE UTTAR PRADESH REORGANISATION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2003

## AN ACT

to amend the Uttar Pradesh Reorganisation Ac<sup>+</sup>, 2000.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Reorga-Short title. nisation (Amendment) Act, 2003. 43 of 1950.

2. For section 18 of the Uttar Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2000, the following section shall be substituted and shall be deemed to have been substituted with effect from the 9th day of November, 2000, namely:-----

18. On and from the appointed day, there shall be one hundred seats in the Legislative Council of Uttar Pradesh, and in the Third Schedule to the Representation of the People Act, 1950, for the existing of entry 8, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:--

"8. Uttar Pradesh ......100 36 8 8 38 10".'.
