NOTIFICATION

No. HC. XI-02/04/9854/RC, the 26th May, 2004. In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 229 of the Constitution of India, the Hon'ble Chief Justice is pleased to make the following Rules further to amend the Gauhati High Court . (the High Court of Assam, Nagaland, Meghalaya, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram and Arunachal Pradesh) Services (Appointment, Condition of Service and Conduct) Rules, 1967, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules, in the manner hereinafter appearing, namely:

- Short title and : 1(i) These Rules may be called the Gauhati High Court Commencement: (the High Court of Assam. Nigaland, Meghalaya, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram and Arunach I Pradesh) Services (Appointment, Condition of Service and Conduct) (Amendment) Rules, 2004.
 - (ii) They shall come into force with immediate effect.
- 2(1) In the Principal Rules, in Rule 7. II the following Sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:
 - "(ii-A) no one who has not passed the H. S. S. L. C. Eximination from a recognized Board/Council and having a diploma/certific te in computer operation shall be eligible to sit for an examination for appointment as a Computer Operator."

- (2) In Sub-rule (iii) of Rule 7. II. after the words "Graduate Typists" the following words, namely, "and Graduate Computer Operators" and after the words "as Salaried Typists" the following words, namely, "and Computer Operators" shall be inserted.
- (3) In Sub-rule (iii-B) after the words "eligible Graduate Typists" the following words, namely, "and Graduate Computer Operators" shall be inserted.
