#### **B. Functions of the Committee :**

- 1) Policy formulation relating to Intodelhna Programme.
- 2) Co-ordination with Development departments for Implementation of the Policy and Programme
- 3) Monitoring and Evaluation of the implementation of the Programme.

## C. Identification of crops and their cultivation under cluster approach.

## Classification of Zones.

- a) Agro-Climatic Zone - Mizoram is divided into three Agro-climatic Zones viz.
- i) The tropical Humid Zone - Comprising the western belt of the State.
  - ii) The Sub-alpine Humid Temperate Zone - Comprising the eastern belt of the State.
  - iii) The Sub-Tropical Humid Zone - Comprising the Central belt of the State.

## Identification of Crops :

## 1) Horticulture/Plantation Crops :

- i) Grapes - Sub-Alpine Temperate Humid Zone
- ii) Passion fruit - Sub-Alpine Temperate Humid Zone, Sub Tropical Humid Zone.
- iii) Red Oil Palm - Tropical Humid Zone, Sub-Tropical Humid Zone.
- iv) Vanilla - All Zones.

## 2) Agriculture Crops :

- 1) Kharif - Paddy, Maize, Soya bean, Arhar.
- 2) Rabi - Potato, Onion, Garlic, Rape & Mustard
- 3) Cluster approach - Identification of villages, areas for cultivation under cluster approach by the concerned Deptt.
