BENEFITS : The Project will enable to transmit Grid Power to different parts of Mizoram, thus limiting use of costly Diesel Generating Sets, improve availability of power for domestic.

POWER FOR PLACING TRANSMISSION LINES, TOWERS, ETC.

For placing Transmission lines, Towers, Wires, Equipments and appliances for the Transmission and Distribution of Electricity or for transmission of Telephone of telegraphic communications necessary for the purpose of undertaking, executing and operation of the scheme, Govt. of Mizoram, therefore, orders that the Department of Power & Electricity shall, in accordance with the provision of Section 67, 68 and 69 of The Electricity Act, 2003 have and shall exercise all the power of the Telegraphic Act, 1885 with respect to Telegraphic lines established or maintained.

Also notice is hereby given, inviting Licences and other persons interested who are likely to be affected, to make representation on the scheme to the undersigned within a period of 2 (two) months with effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette for consideration.
