#### NOTIFICATION

No.C.31018/2/91-DCA/L, the 18th October, 2004. In pursuance of paragraph 11 of the sixth schedule to the Constitution of India, the following Regulation of the Lai Autonomous District Council, which received approval of the Governor of Mizoram is hereby published for General information.

## 1. THE LAI AUTONOMOUS DISTRICT COUNCIL

(Professions, Trades, Callings and Employments Taxation) (first Amendment) Regulation, 2004 (vide Governor of Mizoram approval dt. 9. 10. 2004).

THE LAI AUTONOMOUS DISTRICT COUNCIL (PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND EMPLOYMENTS TAXATION) (FIRST AMENDMENT) REGULATION, 2004.

BILL

to amend the Lai Autonomous District Council (Professions, Trades, Callings and Employments Taxation) Regulation, 2000.

Be it enacted by the Lai Autonomous District Council in the Fifty - Fifth year of Republic of India as follows:-

Short title, extent and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Lai Autonomous District Council (Professions, Trades, Callings and Employment Taxation) (First Amendment) Regutation, 2004.
  - (2) It shall have the like extent as the Principal Regulation.
    - (3) It shall come into force on and from the Ist day of April, 2004.

### Amendment of Section 8.

2. In the Principal Regulation, for Section 8 the following sub-section (4) shall be inserted between sub-section (3) and the Proviso, namely:-"(4) If any person fails to make a return as required by Section 7 or fails to comply with the term of notice issued under sub section (2), theassessing authority shall, by an ordei in writing, assess to the best of his judgement, the person and determine the tax payable by him."

- Amendment of the Schedule 3. (1) For entry No. 7 (2) of the Schedule annexed to the Principal Regulation, the following shall be substituted, namely :-
  - "7.(2) owner of mechanical -

(a) Motor repair works Rs. 2000 P.a.

(b) Two/Three wheeler repair works Rs. 1000 P.a.

Electrical or electronic repair (c) works Rs. 1000 P.a.

(d) Furniture works Rs. 2000 P.a.

(2) For entry No. 7 (3) of the Schedule annexed to the Principal Regulation, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"7.(3) Owner of private boarding School

(a) having below 50 boarders Rs. 1000 P.a.

(b) having above 50 boarders but does not exceed 100 boarders Rs. 2000 P.a.

(c) having above 100 boarders Rs. 2500 P.a.

#### STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The existing rate of tax under entry No. 7 (2) and (3) in the Schedule of the Lai Autonomous District Council (Professions, Trades, Callings and Employments Taxation) Regulation, 2000 is considered comparatively low in view of

the rising gross income of owners of boarding schools, derived from boarding fees paid by the boarders. It is, therefore, considered necessary to increase the existing rate of professional tax payable by the private owners of boarding schools.

Hence the bill.
