#### **N O T I F I C A T I O N**

No. D. 34013/1/89-SC,  
Service and administrative convenience, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to order that the boundary and jurisdiction of nine (9) Soil Conservation Divisions will be as follows:-

1. AIZAWL EAST S&WC DIVISION : Renamed as AIZAWL S&WC Division with its Headquarters at Aizawl. The boundary lines will be the same with AIZAWL DISTRICT boundaries.
2. AIZAWL WEST S&WC DIVISION : Renamed as MAMIT S&WC DIVISION with its Headquarters at Mamit. The boundary lines will be the same with MAMIT DISTRICT boundaries.
3. KHAUZAWL S&WC DIVISION : Its Headquarter will remain at Khawzawl. The boundary lines will be the same with Champhai District Administrative boundaries.
4. SERCHHIP S&WC DIVISION : Its Headquarter will remain at Serchhip and the boundary lines will be the same with Serchhip District Administrative boundaries.
5. HNAHTHIAL S&WC DIVISION : Its Headquarter will remain at Hnahthial and the boundary will be as per Annexure-I

6. LUNGLEI S&WC DIVISION : Its Headquarter will remain at Lunglei and the boundary will be as per Annexure-II
7. LAWNGTLAI S&WC DIVISION : Its Headquarter will remain at Lawngtlai. The boundary lines are as per Annexure-III
8. SAIHA S&WC DIVISION : Its Headquarter will remain at Saiha. The boundary lines are as per Annexure-IV
9. KOLASIB S&WC DIVISION : Its Headquarter will remain at Kolasib and its boundary and jurisdiction shall be as per Annexure-V

All the assets and liabilities of departmental properties coming within the administrative and geographical boundaries of the division will vest within that division itself.

The existing staff and manpower will remain on as is where is basis in the respective Divisions/Ranges.

#### ANNEXURE-I

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF HNAHTHIAL SOIL & WATER CONSERVATION DIVISION

Headquarter	:	Hnahthial
Area	:	1174 Sq. Km
Geographical Position	:	92° 53'-to 93° 17' East Longitude 22° 45' to 23° 14' North Latitude

#### BOUNDARY DETAILED

##### 1) Northern side:

The boundary starts from the crossing point of river Mar and Inter-District boundary line of Lunglei and Serchhip near Rawpui village. It then goes in easterly direction following the Inter-District Administrative boundary line of Serchhip and Lunglei till it meets the International boundary of Myanmar and India.

2) Eastern side :

It then turns towards in Southerly direction by following the International boundary line of Myanmar and India.

3) Southern side :

It then turns towards in westerly direction and it goes along with the Inter-District Administrative boundary line of Saiha and Lunglei District.

4) Western side :

It then turns towards in northerly direction and it goes along with river Mat till it meets the starting point.

**HNAHTHIAL DIVISION INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING RANGES:**

- 1) Hnahthial Soil & Water Conservation Ranges
- 2) S. Vanlaiphai Soil & Water Conservation Ranges

**ANNEXURE-II**

**BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF LUNGLEI SOIL & WATER  
CONSERVATION DIVISION**

Headquarter : Lunglei  
Area : 3365 Sq. Km.  
Geographical Position : 92° 20' to 92° 53' East Longitude  
22° 30' to 23° 21' North Latitude

**BOUNDARY DETAILS**

1) Northern side :

The boundary starts from the confluence of river Khawthlangtuipui and Mar in the western corner near Marpara village and then follows the Inter-District Boundary line of Mamit and Lunglei District in easterly direction till it meets river Tlawng.

2) Eastern side :

It then follows river Mat in Southerly direction till it meet the Inter-District boundary line of Lunglei and Saiha District.

3) Southern side :

It then turns towards westerly direction by following the Inter-District Administrative Boundary line of Lunglei and Lawngtlai District.

## 4) Western side :

It then turns towards in westerly direction and goes along with the International boundary line of Bangladesh and India till it meets the starting point.

Lunglei Division includes the following Ranges :

- 1) Lunglei Soil & Water Conservation Ranges
- 2) Tawipui Soil & Water Conservation Ranges
- 3) Thenhlum Soil & Water Conservation Ranges
- 4) Haulawng Soil & Water Conservation Ranges
- 5) Tlabung Soil & Water Conservation Ranges

## ANNEXURE-III

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF LAWNGTLAI SOIL & WATER  
CONSERVATION DIVISION

Headquarter : Lawngtlai  
Area : 2537.10 Sq. Km  
Geographysical Position : It lies between 92° 32' to 92° 56' East Longitude and 22° 45' to 21° 57' North Latitude.

## BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

## 1) Northern side :

The boundary starts from the International boundary of India and Bangladesh near Borapansuri village. It then follows the Inter-District Administrative boundary line of Lunglei and Lawngtlai District in easterly direction till it meets the Inter-District Administrative boundary of Saiha and Lawngtlai.

## 2) Eastern side :

The boundary line then turns towards in southerly direction and follows the Inter-District Administrative boundary of Saiha and Lawngtlai Districts.

## 3) Southern side :

It then turns towards in easterly direction of following the international boundary line of Myanmar and India till it meets the International boundary of Bangladesh and India.

## 4) Western side :

Lastly, the boundary line follows the International boundary of Bangladesh and India in northerly direction till it meets the starting point.

Lawngtlai Division includes the following Soil & Water Conservation Ranges.

- 1) Lawngtlai Soil & Water Conservation Range
- 2) Diltlang Soil & Water Conservation Range
- 3) Chawnge Soil & Water Conservation Range

#### ANNEXURE IV

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF SAIHA SOIL & WATER CONSERVATION DIVISION

Headquarter : Saiha  
 Area : 1399.90 Sq.Km  
 Geographical Position : It lies between 92° 48' to 93° 14' East Longitude  
 21°55' to 22°45' North Latitude.

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

##### 1) Northern side :

The boundary starts from the confluence of river Chhimtuipui and Darzolui in the north western corner near Vartek village. It then follows the Inter-District boundary line of Lunglei and Saiha in easterly direction, till it meets the confluence of river Tiau and Chhimtuipui near Pangkhua village.

##### 2) Eastern side :

The boundary line then turns towards southern side by following river Chhimtuipui which is also an international boundary of India and Myanmar upto the point near Chapui village.

##### 3) Southern side :

From thence, boundary again follows International boundary of India and Burma in westerly direction till it meets river Chhimtuipui in the down stream side near Lawngmasu village.

##### 4) Western side :

Lastly, the boundary line follows river Chhimtuipui upstream side in northernly direction till it meets the starting point.

Saiha Division includes the following Ranges

- 1) Tuipang Soil & Water Conservation Range.
- 2) Phura Soil & Water Conservation Range
- 3) Saiha Soil & Water Conservation Range

## ANNEXURE-V

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF KOLASIB SOIL & WATER  
CONSERVATION DIVISION

Headquarter : Kolasib  
Area : 1382.51 Sq.Km  
Geographical Position : It lies between 92°33' to 92°56' East Longitude and  
23°46' to 24°34' North Latitude.

## BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

## 1) Northern side :

The boundary line starts from the crossing point of Inter-State boundary line of Tripura, Assam and Mizoram in the North Western corner near Kanhmun village and then it follows the Inter-State boundary line of Assam and Mizoram till it meets the Tuirial river.

## 2) Eastern side :

The boundary line then turns towards the southerly direction by following the Tuirial river upto the Inter-District Administrative boundary line of Aizawl and Kolasib.

## 3) Southern side :

It then turns towards the westerly direction by following the Inter-District boundary line of Aizawl.

## 4) Western side :

Lastly, the boundary line follows the Inter-District boundary line of Mamit and Kolasib in Northerly direction till it meets the confluence of River Tlawng and Teirei. It then follows the Inter-State boundary line of Assam and Mizoram.

Kolasib Soil & Water Conservation Division consists of the following Ranges

- 1) Kolasib Soil & Water Conservation Range
- 2) Vairengte Soil & Water Conservation Range
- 3) Bilkhawthlir Soil & Water Conservation Range
