## THE APPROPRIATION (RAILWAYS) VOTE ON ACCOUNT NO.2 ACT, 2004 AN ACT

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Conscilidated Fund of India for the services of a part of the fluancial year 2004-05 for the purposes of Railways.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (Rail- Short title, ways) Vote on Account No. 2 Act, 2004.
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of India Withdrathere may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those wal of Rs.

specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of forty thousand six hundred seventeen crores, forty-six lakhs, fifty thousand and five hundred rupees [inclusive of the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the Appropriation (Railways) Vote on Account Act, 2004] towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2004-05, in respect of the services relating to Railways specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and Approut of the Consolidated Fund of India by this Act tion, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
