#### TERMS OF REFERENCE:

- 2. The SLQACC will be the information and the source center at State Level for quality sustenance and enhancement activities for Collegiate Education.

3. In addition to this function the SLQACC will publish Manuals/Literature of assessment and accreditation in the Regional language for wider circulation.

#### TERMS OF REFERENCE:

- 1. To conduct awareness programmes throughout the State on Quality Assurance related issues.
- 2. To motivate the College and other Higher Education Institutions in the State to undergo assessment and accreditation based on phase wise plan of accreditation to be prepared in consultation with NAAC.
- 3. To assist NAAC in initiating post accreditation quality sustenance measure in the State.
- 4. To help NAAC in achieving the targets of assessment and accreditation in a case of affiliated colleges.
- 5. To advise the State Govt, to initiate suitable measures for ascertaining the maintenance of minimum standard in Higher Education.
- 6. To advise NAAC on the quality assurance activities to be taken up by the Higher Education Institutions in the State for achieving globally acceptable quality standard.
