#### **NOTIFICATION**

No. A. 33043/27/2001-P&AR (TRG), the 31st March, 2005. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Regulations to amend the Mizoram (Training in Accounts Course) Regulations, 1991 issued under Notification No. A. 33043/8/89-P&AR (TRG) dated 24. 6. 91 and herein after called the principal Regulations:

Short Title and Commence-  
ment. 1. (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram (Training in Accounts Course) (second Amendment) Regulations, 2005.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Mizoram Gazette.

Amendment of Para 3 of the Principal Regulations. 2. In the principal Regulations for sub-para (1) of para 3, the following paragraph shall be substituted namely ;

“The Government shall impart training in Accounts Course for Assistants and UDCs who are working at least one year as such in the case of Assistants and two years as such in the case of UDCs. Duration of the Course shall be 3 (three) months or more as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time, and a minimum of 3(three) months duration shall be the standard duration. The Training Course is restricted to only once during entire career, that means, that if the Training Course is attended during the tenure as UDC, then no other same training shall be allowed for the same person after promotion to the post of Assistants”.

Amendment of  
para 4 of the  
principal  
Regulation.

3. In the principal Regulations, for para 3, the following paragraph shall be substituted, namely ;

"Any Assistants or Upper Division Clerks who have undergone the Training and passed the final examination conducted by the Government at the end of the Training Course shall be eligible for payment of cash incentive of Rs. 1,500/- (Rupees one thousand five hundred) only in the case of Assistants and Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand) only in the case of UDCs, with effect from the date of declaration of the Result".

Sub-para (a), (b) and (c) of para 4 stand repealed.
