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#### **NOTIFICATION**

No. A.12018/48/2004-P&AR (GSW), the 14th June, 2005. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules relating to the recruitment to the post(s) of Junior Staff Officer and Centre Commander under Mizoram Home Guards Department, Government of Mizoram, namely :-

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| Short title and commencement.                              | 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Home Guards (Group 'B' post) Recruitment Rules, 2005.<br>(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. |
| Application.   | 2. The Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.  |
| Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.          | 3. The number of the said post(s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the First Schedule as aforesaid.                      |
| Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications. | 4. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the First Schedule aforesaid.  |

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

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| Disqualification | 5. No person -<br>(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or |
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(b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post(s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.

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| <b>Training and Departmental Examination.</b> | 6. Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.   |
| <b>Power to transfer</b>                      | 7. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, shall have the rights and powers to transfer any Officer so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.  |
| <b>Power to Relax</b>                         | 8. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons. |
| <b>Reservation and other concessions</b>      | 9. Nothing in these rules shall effect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.                 |
| <b>Repeal &amp; Savings.</b>                  | 10. All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Mizoram under Notification No. A. 12018/32/80-APT(B) & A. 12018/32/80-APT(B) dated 13.5.87 & 11.5.1991 Issue No. 50 (c) & 93 dated 13.15.87 & 20.5.93 stands hereby repealed:   |

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
