#### **NOTIFICATION**

No. A. 22011/1/92-P&E, the 3rd November, 2006. In exercise of the power conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules, namely :—

1. Title                      These rules shall be called “The transfer rules for group ‘B’ ‘C’ & ‘D’ employees excluding J.E. of Power & Electricity Department”
2. Commencement      They shall be deemed to have come into force from the date of publication of notification in the Official Gazette.

#### **GENERAL GUIDING PRINCIPLES**

3. There shall not be partiality among the employees in transfer and posting.
4. Transfer & posting of employees to their home town or to the nearest place of the employees home town shall be adopted as far as practicable.
5. The policy of the Government for posting of husband and wife at the same station shall be observed.
6. Transfer and posting of employees shall be made within the same station if possible.
7. Employees who are due to retire on superannuation within two years shall not ordinarily be disturbed from their existing place of posting unless there is a specific reason.

### CLASSIFICATION OF POSTING PLACES

8. State Capital Aizawl as 'A' Class.
9. Divisions and Sub-Divisions in and around District Headquarters except Saiha and Lawngtlai as 'B' Class.
10. Saiha, Lawngtlai, Project Divisions and Sub-Divisions and other remote areas within the State as 'C' Class.

### TENURE OF POSTING

11. 'A' Class - 10 years in the same office.
12. 'B' Class 5 years in the same office
13. 'C' Class 2 years in the same office

### RELAXATION

14. When there is exigencies public service so required
15. When there is administrative reasons
16. When there is special deserving case on the part of the employees on ground of illness etc.
17. When there is no vacant post to their home town to accommodate the employees.
