OFFICE MEMORANDUM

No.A. 17019/1/2001-F. Est/Pt, 17th November, 2006.

Subj: Clarification of the implementation of the Mizoram Group Health Scheme, 2006.

In continuation to this Department's Office Memorandum No.A. 17019/1/2001-F.Est/Pt, (Loose) dt. 13.11.2006, the Government of Mizoram in the Finance Department consider it expedient to issue the following clarifications for information to all concerned that:

- 1. The Mizoram Government Group Health Scheme, 2006 shall not be applicable to the members of All India Services, Judges of the High Court, Government Advocates and employees of the Aizawl Bench of the High Court. The existing CCS (Medical Attendance) Rules etc as applicable to them before introduction of this Scheme shall continue to govern the aforementioned groups.
- 2. The Scheme shall be applicable to the employees of Mizoram Public Service Commission, Governor Secretariat and Mizoram Legislative Assembly Secretariat. But it shall not apply to Ministers, Speaker, Deputy Speaker and MLAs who are governed by independent Salaries Rules.
- 3. The patients who had undergone treatment outside the State on or after 01.10.2006 requiring review should go through Screening Committee. Thereafter, the ICICI Lombard GIC Ltd. shall arrange to send the patients to the same Hospital where as far as practicable.

- 4. For referment outside the State the recommendation of Medical Board duly constituted by the Health & Family Welfare Department with membership from ICICI Lombard GIC Ltd. is considered sufficient.
- 5. The Scheme is intended to cover proven cases of illness and hospitalized cases and not necessarily of investigation and experimental cases.
- 6. The number of Attendant can be allowed as per recommendation of the Medical Board. And diet/fooding charge to the attendant shall also be covered under the Scheme.
- 7. Hospitals run by Central Government, other State Governments, and the State Government of Mizoram shall be automatically approved and the bills of these Hospitals are reimbursed where cashless facilities is not available.
