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#### **NOTIFICATION**

No.A.12018/54/2005-PAR(GSW), the 25th May, 2007. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to recruitment to the post (s) of Havildar Instructor, Junior Instructor, Kote Havildar, Quarter Guard Havildar, Quarter Master Havildar, Demonstrator Havildar, Brass Band Havildar, Havildar, Armourer Havildar and Storeman under Mizoram Home Guard Department, Government of Mizoram, namely:—

Short Title and Commencement. 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Home Guard Department (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2007.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Application. 2. These Rules shall apply to the post specified in Column 1 of the First schedule herto annexed.

Number of posts, classification and scale of pay. 3. The number of the said post(s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the First Schedule as aforesaid.

Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications. 4. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in column 5 to 14 of the First Schedule aforesaid.

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

**Disquali-  
fication.**

5. No person—  
 (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or  
 (b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post (s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

**Training  
and Depart-  
mental  
Examination.**

6. Every Government servant recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

**Power to  
transfer.**

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and power to transfer any officers so recruited under these Rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

**Power to  
relax.**

8. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.

**Reserva-  
tions and  
other Con-  
cessions.**

9. Nothing in these rules shall affect any other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.

**Repeal and  
Savings.**

10. All Rules pertaining to these posts of framed by ment of Mizoram under Notification No. 12018/324/82-APT (6) dated 25.08.1982 Issue No. 50 dated 27.08.1982 stand hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
