## NOTIFICATIONS

S.O.— Whereas the Election Commission has reviewed the position regarding the continued existence or otherwise of all the unrecognised political parties registered under paragraph 3 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968.

And whereas the Commission has decided on the basis of the above review that some of the political parties registered under the said order, namely :—

- (i) Backward Classes Party of India,
- (ii) Bihar Prantiya Sudharvadi Party
- (iii) Federation of Muslims and other Minorities,
- (iv) Hindustani Shoshit Dal,
- (v) India National Democratic Front,
- (vi) Kshaatra Samagra,
- (vii) Kerala Samyukta Socialist Party,
- (viii) Krantikari Communist Party of India,
- (ix) Lok Tantrik Congress,
- (x) Mazdoor Parishad,
- (xi) The Minorities League,
- (xii) Paschim Banga Krisak Samaj,
- (xiii) Republican Party of India (Ambedkarite,)

- (xiv) Samajvadi Congress, and  
 (xv) Shiromani Akali Dal (Gurnam Singh)

have ceased to exist and consequently have become defunct ;

And whereas it is necessary to give effect to these decisions and also bring the position up-to-date in regard to unrecognised registered political parties and the State or States in which they function ;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of clause (c) of sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 17 of the said Order, and in supersession of its notification No. 56/73-11 (S.O. 515 E), dated 24 September, 1973, published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part 11, Section 3 (ii), dated 24 September, 1973, the Election Commission hereby specifies in the Table below, the unrecognised registered political parties and the State or States in which they function :—

### ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA

S.O.—Whereas it has been decided by the Commission under paragraph 16 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, that the Party Bharatiya Lok Dal formed as a result of the amalgamation of the Swatantra Party, the Bharatiya Kranti Dal and the Utkal Congress, should be a National Party for the purposes of the said Order ;

And whereas the Commission has further decided under the said order that the Symbols (i) "Star" reserved for the Swatantra Party, (ii) "Haldhar" reserved for the Bharatiya Kranti Dal in Uttar Pradesh and (iii) "Water wheel and plough (Halchaka)" reserved for the Utkal Congress in Orissa should be frozen ;

And whereas on intimation from Mizo Union, a recognised State Party in the Union Territory of Mizoram and the Indian National Congress, a recognised National Party, it has been decided by the Commission that the former Party has merged with the Indian National Congress ;

And whereas it is necessary to give effect the position up-to-date in regard to specification of political parties as National and State Parties and the symbols reserved for them and of the free symbols for each State ;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of sub-para (1) (a), (b) and (d) of paragraph 17 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, and in supersession of its notification No. 56/73-1 (S.O.180 E) dated 29 March, 1973 published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3 (ii), dated 29 March, 1973, the Commission hereby specifies :--

- (a) the National Parties and the Symbols respectively reserved for them in Table I,
- (b) the State Parties, the State of States in which they are State Parties, and the symbols respectively reserved for them in such State or States in Table 2, and
- (c) the free symbols for each State in Table 3.
