NOTIFICATIONS

No. COOP. 28/73/Pt, the 23th August, 1979. In exercise of the powers conferred by the provise to Article 309 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/11/71-HMT-(ii) dated the 21st January, 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Deputy Registar in the Co-Operative Societies Department, Government of Mizoram, namely:

- 1. Short title and commencement
- 1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Co-operative Department (Group 'A') Recruitment Rules, 1975.
- 2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application
- These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.
- 3. Number of posts classification and scale of pay
- The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Scheduled aforesaid.
- 4. Method of rectt.: age limit and other qualification
- The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as Specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the said Scheduled.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for rectt, may be relaxed in the case of candidates below to the Scheduled Castis, Scheduled Tribes and other Special a legaries of persons in a cordinace with the orders issued by the legtral Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification

: No person:

a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage a person having a spouse living,

OR

b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, is satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6 Training and Departmental Examination

: Every Govt. servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

7 Power to relax: Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax may of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or extegory of persons.

8 Reservation

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other other Concessions: concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Custes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

9 Repeal and saving: All Rules pertaining to these poses, framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Govt. of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in persuance of flower of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (iii dt. 21, 1, 1972 are herear repealed.
