ACT

to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1973, in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation Act, 1979. Short title:
  2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram, the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this Act amounting in the aggregate to the sum of fifty lakhs, eighteen thousand and five hundred rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied to meet the amount spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1973, in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year.
- Issue of Rs. 50,18,500 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram to meet certain excess expenditure for the year ended on the 31st March, 1973;

3. The sums deemed to have been authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union Territory of Mizoram under this Act shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1972. ## MIZORAM ACT NO 2 OF 1979

The Mizoram Appropriation (No 2) Act, 1979

(Received the assent of the Lt. Governor (Administrator) Mizoram on 4.10.1979)

### AN ACT

to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1974, in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 1979. Short title:
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram, the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this Act amounting in the aggregate to the sum of two crores, thirty-three lakhs, twenty-three thousand one hundred and fifty-nine rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied to meet the amount spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1974, in excess of the amounts granted for those services and for that year. Issue of Rs 2, 33, 23, 159 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram to meet certain excess expenditure for the year ended on the 31st March, 1974.

The sums deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram under this Act shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March, 1974; Appropriation.

### MIZORAM ACT NO 3 OF 1979

The Mizoram Appropriation (No 3) Act, 1979.

(Received the assent of the Lt. Governor (Administrator) Mizoram on 4.10.1979)

#### AN ACT

to authorise the appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram for the services of the financial year 1979-80.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Thirtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation ( No. 3 ) Act, 1979.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate (inclusive of the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 1979 (Central Act 13 of 1979) to the sum of seventy-one crores, twenty-three lakhs and fifty-five thousand rupees, towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1979-80 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
