NOTIFICATION

No. MAC. 15/80/4, the 2nd April, 1980. In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 248 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Mizoram Legislative Assembly, the following amendments to the said Rules as approved by the House on 27th March, 1980 are hereby published :

1. In rule 35, after the words "nature of the question (starred or unstarred)" the words "the date on which the question is proposed to be placed on the list of questions for answers" should be added.

2. Rule 44 should be split up into two sub-rules and reworded as follows —

"44 (1) Questions which have not been disallowed shall be entered in the list of questions for the day for oral or written answer, as the case may be, in accordance with the orders of the Speaker.

(2) Questions for oral answers shall be called if the time made available for questions permits, in the order in which they stand on the list before any other business is entered upon at the sitting:

Provided that a question not reached for oral answer may be answered after the end of the Question Hour with the permission of the Speaker, if the Minister represents to the Speaker that the question is one of special interest to which he desires to give a reply.

3. The following rule 47 (2) should be added after rule 47, the original rule may be renumbered as rule 47(1)—

"47 (2) In case where no intimation has been received by the Speaker from an absent member, the question shall be passed over on the question together with its answer shall form part of the proceedings of the day."

No. G-11020/10/79-STAD, the 2nd Amendment, in exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to Article 109 of the Constitution of India the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification No. 14/21/79 H.I. 1/79 dated the 21st January, 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Punch Supervisor and Punch Operator under Economics & Statistics Department, Govt. of Mizoram.

1. **Short title and Commencement** : 1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Economics & Statistics Department (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1989.
2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Application** : These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.
3. **Number of posts classification and scale of pay** : The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the scheduled schedule.
4. **Method of Recruitment age limit and other qualification** : The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the said Scheduled.

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons, or in the case of persons who have been issued by the Central Government a certificate of exemption from time to time.
5. **Disqualification** : No person:
a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living or
b) who, having a spouse living and not divorced or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may be satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, except any person from the operation of this rule.
6. **Training and Departmental Examination** : Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

- 7 Power to relax : Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 8 Reservation : Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, other concessions the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
- 9 Repeal and Saving : All Rules pertaining to these posts, framed by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dated 21. 1. 1972 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken the corresponding provisions of these rules.
