#### ORDERS BY THE ADMINISTRATOR NOTIFICATIONS

No. MC. 4/15/72, the 1st. September, 1980. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act 1932 (Act No. 23 of 1932), the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare that all offences punishable under sections 186, 188, 189, 190, 228, 295—A. 298, 505, 506 and 507 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 (Act No. 45 of 1860), when committed in the area specified below, shall not with standing anything contant in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act No. 2 of 1974), be cognizable.

This Notification shall remain in force for a period of simmonths.

### AREA SPECIFIED The whole of Union Territory of Mizoram

No. MC. 4/15/72: In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 10 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1932 (Act No. 23 of 1932), the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare that in the area specified below, offences punishable under sections 188 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Act No. 15 of 1863), shall notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, (Act No. 2 of 1974) be non-bailable.

This Notification shall remain in force for a period of six months.

#### ORDERS BY THE ADMINISTRATOR

No. IVIC. 4/13/12, the 1st. September, 1980. Whereas certain groups of persons are still actively involved in creating disorder and disturbance to peace and tranquility in Mizoram.

And, whereas the Administrator of Mizoram after careful consideration of all facts and circumstances is satisfied that in order to make adequate provision for the suppression of the disorder and maintenance of the public order and communications in Mizoram and for the protection of life and property of the loyal citizens therein, it is necessary to declrae the whole of the Union Territory of Mizoram as disturbed area;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Assam Disturbed Areas Act, 1955 (Assam Act XIX of 1955), the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare the whole of the Union Territory of Mizoram as disturbed area under the said Act for a period of six months.
