NOTIFICATIONS

No. EES. 212/74/PL/93-8 the 27th May, 1981. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT-(ii) dated the 21st January, 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Primary School Teacher under Education & Social Welfare Department Government of Mizoram, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement. : 1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram, Education & Social Welfare Deptt. (Group 'C' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1980.
2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. These Rules shall apply to the post specified in column of the Schedule hereto annexed.
3. Number of posts classification and scale of pay. : 3) The number of the said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Scheduled aforesaid.
4. Method of recruitment age limit and other qualification. : The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.
Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time.
5. Disqualification : No person:
a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 7 **Power to : Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is neces-**

- 8 **Reservation : Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation and other**
other concessions concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes,
the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accor-
dance with the orders issued by the Central Government or
Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
- 9 **Repeal and : All Rules pertaining to these posts, framed by the Go-**
Saving vernor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were
in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in
existence in pursuance of Government of India, Ministry of
Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dated 21. 1.
1972 and post at Sl.No.15 Schedule attached to Government of
Mizoram, Education and Social Welfare Department Notifica-
tion No. FE. 60/74-75/36/41 dated 10.4. 1975 published in the
Mizoram Gazette on 20.2.1976 Issue No. 8 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken the corresponding provisions of these rules.
