#### ANNEXURE

##### EXISTING BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF KANHMUN FOREST RANGE

North : Starting from the pillar of tri-junction of Inter-State boundary of Mizoram, Tripura and Assam, the boundary follows the inter-state boundary of Mizoram and Assam towards east up to the point where the inter-state boundary takes its turn towards south (at about 1½ km North Eastern from Lusaicherra).

East : Thence the boundary runs towards South following the said inter-state boundary up to the point where it (the inter-state boundary) is met by the western Riverine Reserved boundary of Teirei Riverine Reserve up to Rengdil and Kawrthah inter village boundary.

South : Thence the boundary follows the above inter-village boundary (i.e. Rengdil and Kawrthah villages) towards west up to the Langkaih river which is inter-state boundary of Mizoram and Tripura.

West : Thence it follows the inter-state boundary, the Langkaih river down stream up to the point where the Northern boundary starts.

Area in Sq. Km (Approx) -- 270

##### EXISTING PROPOSED BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF KOLASIB FOREST RANGE

North : Starting from the meeting point of Saihapui river and Inner Line Reserve boundary, the boundary follows the Inner Line Reserve boundary due east upto the Serlui river.

East : Thence the boundary follows the Serlui river up stream upto Sarali.

South : From Sarali the boundary runs towards west following along the inter village boundary of Thingdawl and Kawnpui villages upto Nekachawchhumkawn at the western bank region of the Tui-chhuahen river (This is a northern boundary of Kawnpui Forest Range also).

West : From Nekachawchhumkawn it runs towards north till it meets the source of Saihapui river and it follows the Saihapui river down stream upto Inner Line Reserve where the northern boundary starts.

Area in S. Km (Approx) -- 204

##### EXISTING BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF VAIRENGTE FOREST RANGE

North : Starting from the point where the Inter State boundary of Mizoram and Assam is crossed by the Aizawl Silchar Road the boundary follows the Inter state boundary of Mizoram and Assam South eastern direction upto the Serlui River.

East : Thence, the boundary follows the Serlui river upstream upto the mouth of Chemlui. Thence follows the Chemlui river upstream upto the southern boundary of Inner Line Reserved Forest.

**South :** Thence, it runs along the Inner Line Reserved boundary Westward and crossed Aizawl — Silchar main road upto the point (pillar) where the western boundary of Aizawl Silchar Roadside Reserved meets the Inner Line Reserve Forest boundary.

**West :** Thence, the boundary runs towards north at  $\frac{1}{2}$  a mile distance from along the Aizawl—Silchar main road till it meets Bilkhawthlir Buhchang Road. Thence it proceeds further towards north and comes over to the source of the Chhimluang river, thence to the source of Aithanglui. Then it follows the Aitlang river downstream and along the Inter state boundary of Mizoram and Assam till it meets and Aizawl—Silchar Road where the Northern boundary starts.

Area in Sq. Km. (Approx) 192

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF SAIPUM FOREST RANGE (PROPOSED)

**North :** Starting from the point where the Serlui river is met by the inter state boundary of Mizoram and Assam from its right its right bank the boundary follows the inter state boundary towards east upto the meeting point of Inter Division boundary of Kolasib and Aizawl Forest Division on the Inter state boundary.

**East :** Thence, the boundary follows the Inter Division boundary towards south upto the crossing point of the Inter Division boundary and the Southern boundary of Inner Line Reserve.

**South :** Thence, the boundary follows the Inner Line Forest Reserve boundary towards west upto the Chemlui river.

**West :** Thence, the boundary follows the Chemlui downstream upto its mouth to the Serlui. Thence, it follows the Serlui downstream upto the Inter State boundary of Mizoram and Assam where the Northern boundary starts.

Area in Sq. Km. (Approx) - 172

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF BUKPUI FOREST RANGE (PROPOSED)

**North :** Starting from the crossing point of Inner Line Reserve boundary and Serlui River, the boundary follows the inner line Reserved boundary Line towards east upto the Inter Division boundary of Kolasib and Aizawl Forest Division.

**East :** Thence the boundary follows the Inter Division boundary towards south upto Serkhan village.

**South & West :** From Serkhan the boundary follows Aizawl—Silchar Road north-wards and comes over to the source of the Serlui river. Thence it follows the Serlui downstream upto the starting point of the northern boundary at the river (Serkui).

Area in Sq. Km. (Approx) -- 179

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF KAWNPUI FOREST RANGE (PROPOSED)

**North :** Starting from Nekachawohhumkawn, the boundary runs towards east following the inter village boundary of Thingdawl and Kawnpui village upto Serlui at Serlui river (This is the southern boundary of Kolasib Forest Range also).

**East :** Thence, the boundary follows Serlui river upstream and comes over to the Serkhan village.

**South & West :** From Serkhan the boundary follows Aizawl—Silchar Road north wards and comes over to the source of the Serlui river. Thence it follows the Serlui downstream upto the starting point of northern boundary at the river (Serkui).

Area in Sq. Km. (Approx) -- 269

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF BUHCHANG FOREST RANGE (PROPOSED)

**North :** Starting from the meeting point of Tuichhachcha river and Inter-State boundary of Mizoram and Assam the boundary follows the inter-state boundary of Mizoram and Assam towards North upto the source of Aitlang river.

**East :** Thence the boundary runs due east and falls to the Chhimluang river. Thence it comes to Bilkhawthlir Buhchang Road. Thence, it proceeds towards south at a distance of  $\frac{1}{2}$  a mile from along Aizawl—Silchar Road (Approx) till it meets southern boundary of Inner Line Reserve Forest (This is a portion of western boundary of Vairengte range).



South : Thence the boundary follows the Inner Line Reserved boundary due west upto Inter-state boundary of Mizoram and Assam.

West : Thence the boundary follows the said inter-state boundary towards northeast direction upto Tui-chhuahsen river.

Area in Sq. Km. (Approx) -- 171

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF BAIRABI FOREST RANGE (PROPOSED)

North : Starting from the point where the inter-state boundary of Mizoram and Assam meets the Tlawng river, the boundary due north upto the point where the Southern boundary line of Inner Line Reserved bifurcates from the inter state boundary. Thence the boundary follows the Inner Line Reserve boundary towards east upto the Saihapui river.

East : Thence the boundary follows the Saihapui river upstream upto the source and comes over to the Thinglubul tang. Thence following Thinglubul tangdung towards south it comes over to Dilzau, thence to the Tlawng river.

South : From the Tlawng river, the boundary runs straight south westernly and comes to the mouth of Tut River (Tut chhuah).

Thence the boundary goes south westernly direction and comes over to the source of the Suanglui stream and follows the Suanglui downstream upto its mouth to the Teirei river and crossing the Teirei river it proceeds straight towards west and meets the western boundary of the Teirei Riverine Reserved Forests.

West : Thence the boundary follows the western Riverine Reserved boundary of Teirei river towards north upto the inter-state boundary of Mizoram and Assam. Thence it follows the inter-state boundary along the rivers Teirei and Tlawng downstream and meets the starting point of the northern boundary at Tlawng river.

Area in Sq. Km. (Approx) -- 222

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF KAWRTHAH (TUIDAM)

North : Starting from the Langkaih river, the boundary follows Rengdil and Kawrthah inter village boundary towards east upto the Teirei river. Thence it crosses the Teirei due east and meets eastern boundary of Teirei Riverine Reserve.

East : Thence it follows the eastern boundary of Teirei Riverine Reserve towards south upto the inter Divisional boundary of Aizawl and Kolasib Forest Division.

South : Thence it follows along the inter Division boundary upto the source of Phuldungsei Tuikhur.

West : Thence the boundary follows inter-state boundary and Tripura towards north and along the Langkaih river upto the point where the northern boundary starts at Langkaih river.

Area in Sq. Km. (Approx) -- 275

#### BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF MAMIT FOREST RANGE (PROPOSED)

North : Starting from the point where the Suanglui river is crossed by the eastern boundary of Teirei riverine Reserve, the boundary goes north easternly direction and comes over to Tutchhuah at Tlawng river. Thence the boundary goes straight due east upto the mouth of Saiphai lui to the Tlawng river.

East : Thence the boundary follows the Saiphai lui upstream upto the source and then comes to the deserted village of Tawitaw which is on the inter Division boundary of Aizawl and Kolasib Forest Division. Thence it follows the inter Division boundary towards west upto Aizawl Tuipuibari Road.

South : Thence the boundary follows the inter-Division boundary (Aizawl -Tuipuibari Road) towards west upto the eastern Riverine Reserve boundary of Teirei river.

West : Thence the boundary follows along the eastern boundary line of Teirei riverine Reserve towards north upto the Suanglui where the northern boundary starts.
