NOTIFICATION

No. LRR.77/73-81/35(A)/72-75, the 2nd June, 1982. In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Mizo District (Land and Revenue) Act, 1956 (Act No. 1 of 1957) as adapted, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union territory of Mizoram is pleased to declare that the boundaries of the Aizawl Town shall be as indicated in the Annexure to the notification with immediate effect orders. This supercedes this Department's Notification No. LRR.52/73-74/34-39 of 28th October, 1974.

ANNEXURE AIZAWL TOWN BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

Starting Point : Starting Point is at the confluence of Sele Lui and Ramri Lui, tri-junction of Sihphir, Durtlang and Muthi villages jurisdiction. The north-eastern corner of Aizawl Town area is used as a starting point where the boundary Pillar No. 1 stands just on the western edge of river Tuipawl Lui within the jurisdiction of Durtlang village.

A. NORTH

From the starting point the boundary line runs westwards following the mid-stream of Sele Lui upto the Saddle of Selesih (Selesih Kawn) along the Aizawl-Silchar Road at the northern end of Aizawl town area where the boundary Pillar No. 2 stands just the eastern edge of the Aizawl-Silchar Road.

From Pillar No. 2 the boundary runs westward following the mid stream of Bengbawng Lui upto the confluence with the stream which comes from Hmingziak Tlang. The boundary Pillar No. 3 is fixed here. From Pillar No 3 the boundary turn to southwards following the mid stream which comes from Saphal Tlang and meet Saphal Tlang. Boundary Pillar No. 4 is fixed here. From Pillar No. 4 the boundary goes directly south-wards and meet the westmost corner of the hillock of Tlaklam Khawhmun Hlui of western skirt of Durtlang. The Pillar No. 5 is fixed here. From Boundary Pillar No. 5 it goes to south-wards directly and meet Sakei Khawthlir Tlang. The Boundary Pillar No. 7 is fixed here. The Boundary Pillar No. 6 is fixed at the top of highest hillock, mid point between Pillar No. 5 & 7. From Pillar No. 7 the boundary goes to south-wards to meet the confluence of Lungrem Tuikhur and Leitan Lui. Boundary Pillar No. 8 is fixed here. From Boundary Pillar No. 8 the boundary follows the mid-stream of Leitan Lui to westwards upto the confluence with Mel 5 Lui. The Boundary Pillar No. 9 is fixed here. From Boundary Pillar No. 9 the boundary follows the mid river of Sairang Lui to North West-wards upto the confluence with Hratzang Lui. Boundary Pillar No. 10 is fixed here. From Boundary Pillar No. 10 the boundary follows the mid Hratzang Lui to South-wards and the stream which comes from Belkhai Kawn and meet the Belkhai Kawn. The Boundary Pillar No. 10 is fixed here. This point is 92 degree 40.27" Longitude and 23 degree 46.38" Latitude. From Boundary Pillar No. 11 the bounday goes to westwards following the small stream which meet Belkhai Lui. Bounday Pillar No. 12 is fixed at this confluence. This point is 92 degree 40.22" Longitude and 23 degree 46.37" Latitude.

B. WEST :

By starting from Pillar No. 12 as already mentioned above the boundary follows mid stream of Belkhai Lui to South-wards upto Belkhai kawn, south of Hmunte tlang. From this point the boundary deflects to westerly direction upto 92 degree 40' and 23 degree 46' north of Kelthih Lui. Here, Pillar No. 15 is fixed. Pillar No. 14 is fixed mid point between Pillar No. 13 & 15. From Pillar No. 15 the boundary follows Longitude Line of 92 degree 40' straightly to south-wards upto the confluence of Tuithum Lui and Sihpui Lui. Pillar No. 26 is fixed at this point. Between Pillar No. 15 and 26 ten Pillars are fixed consecutively. The Pillar No. 26 the boundary follows the mid stream of Tuithum lui upto the confluence with river Tlawng. Pillar No. 27 is fixed at this point. From Pillar No. 27 the boundary follows eastern edge of river Tlawng to South-wards up to the confluence with river Serlui. Boundary Pillar No. 28 is fixed at this point. From Pillar No. 28 the boundary follows mid river Serlui to South East direction upto the confluence with Tuikhur Lui (South Hlimen) Boundary Pillar No 29. is fixed at this point.

C. SOUTH:

Starting from the last point as mentioned above, i.e. the confluence of Ser Lui and Tuikhur Lui where Pillar No. 29 is fixed the boundary follows the mid stream of Tuikhur Lui upto the confluence with Arbai Lui. Boundary Pillar No. 30 is fixed herewith. From Pillar No. 30 the boundary follows the mid stream of Arbai Lui and meet the nearest hill top of Chuhvel Tlang measuring from Mauhak Kawn. Boundary Pillar No. 31 is fixed here. From this the boundary follows the mid-stream of Mauhak Lui to South-wards upto the confluence with river Ser Lui. Pillar No 32 is fixed here. From this the boundary follows the mid stream of Ser Lui East-wards upto Raldan Kawn or Chalkunga Inhmun Kawn. Pillar No. 33 is fixed at this saddle. From this the boundary follows the mid stream of Tuikhawthla Lui to easterly direction upto the confluence with Thingzam Lui to easterly direction upto the confluence with Thingzam Lui. Pillar No. 34 is fixed here.

D. EAST:

Starting from Pillar No. 34 as mentioned above i.e. Pillar No. 34 the boundary follows the mid stream of Thingzam Lui to North-wards upto the confluence with river Chite Lui. Pillar No. 35 is fixed here. From this the boundary follows the western edge of river Chite Lui to North-wards upto the confluence with Ngawpui Lui. Pillar No. 36 is fixed herewith. From Pillar No. 36 the boundary follows the mid stream of Ngawpui Lui to east-wards and meet the small mound nearby the lowest saddle along the ridge line between Ex-Zokhawsang and Sanga Bawk Villages. Pillar No. 37 is fixed here. From this the boundary defects to North East direction and meet the eastern most hillock of Ex-Zokhawsang Village. Pillar No. 38 is fixed here. From this the boundary goes directly to North-East-wards and meet the top of Bel Lui Kawn Tlang. Pillar No. 39 is fixed here. From this the boundary follows the mid stream of Pialtlep Lui to North-wards upto the confluence with Beraw Lui. Pillar No. 40 is fixed here. From this the boundary follows the mid stream of Beraw Lui to North-East direction upto the confluence with Muthi Lui. Pillar No. 41 is fixed here. From this the boundary again follows the mid stream of Muthi Lui to North West direction and meet the Ramri Kawn (Saddle between Durtlang and Muthi Village) Pillar No. 42 is fixed here. From this the boundary follows the mid stream of Ramri Lui (Durtlang and Muthi) to North-ward and meet Pillar No. 1 (Starting point), at the confluence of Sele and Ramri Lui as mentioned in the 1st. para.

NOTIFICATION

No. C. 21016/1/81-HMP, the 1st June, 1982. WHEREAS it is apprehended that some employees of the Government of Mizoram, may resort to strike ;

2. AND WHEREAS the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram, having regard to the circumstances prevailing in the Union Territory of Mizoram, is satisfied that in the public interest it is necessary to prohibit strike in certain essential services ;

3. NOW, therefore, in exercise of the Powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Services Maintenance Act, 1981 (Act 40 of 1981) read with the Notification of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs No. S.O. 11(E) dated the 7th January, 1982, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram is pleased to prohibit strike in any of the essential services specified below namely —

- i) any service in, or in connection with the working of, any system of public conservancy, sanitation or water supply, hospitals or dispensaries in the Union Territory of Mizoram.;

- ii) any service in any establishment or undertaking dealing with the production, supply of distribution of power in the Union Territory of Mizoram ;
- iii) any service in connection with the affairs of the Union Territory of Mizoram.

ANNEXURE

Boundary Description of Hnahthial station.

- Starting Point : A point where the Khamrang lui, and BRTF road meets together on the Southern side of the Town itself is used as starting point.
- Southern side : From that starting point mentioned above the Boundary line goes towards the east along the Khamrang nullah till the Phullui meets Sa-ang road. From that Sa-ang road the boundary line goes down in the same direction along the Phullui till it reaches Jhum road.
- Eastern side : Starting from that Jhum road the boundary line goes towards the North along the Jhum road and passing through Chalthuama's Tuikhur. Thence it goes on towards in the same direction and passes through Rolawma's Leilet kawn, and also Pu Tluanga (Aithur) Tuikhur. Thence it goes towards the North-west and crossing the E.G.S. road below the Thana Range and passing along the area of Teak Plantation and meets Hramvunga Huan kawn. Thence it goes towards the North-west till it meets Kawn-pui Lui.

- Northern side : From that point the Boundary line goes up towards the West along the Kawnpui lui till it meets BRTF main road. Thence the Boundary line goes down in the same direction along the Kawnpui nullah till it reaches 300.00m.
- Western side : From that 300.m point the boundary line goes towards the South in a straight line till it reaches Kikawn point. Thence it follows down the Rihte nullah in the direction till Khamrang lui meets Rihte nullah.
- Southern side : From that point the boundary line runs up towards the east along the nullah and reaches the starting point.
