ANNEXURE

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION OF KAWNPUL AREA

Starting point from the South:

- South: Starting from stream junction with Leichal Kawr, at a distance of 500.50 Metres from the Aizawl Silchar B.R.T.F. Road (East of the Road) the boundary follows the Leichal Kawr—towards its source. By crossing the Aizawl—Silchar Road and foot-path coming 'rom Ex-Mualvum it deflects to north west direction along the flank of Tuikual Lui catchment area by encircling the old safety reserve of Mualvum Village till it meets Chhawllen Kham.
- WEST: Starting from Chhawllen Kham the boundary follows the scarpand cliff along the ridge line, to northwards upto Thingzaitlang of Hortoki Road. From this it goes directly to north-wards by crossing western cliff or scarp of Khawserhsuang Tlang it meets the western safety reserve of Bualpui Village, at a distance of 320 Metres from the Main Road. From this point it goes to northwards upto stream Junction of Bualzaw Lui, at a distance of 550.00 Metres from the Main Road. Again, from this it follows the said stream for a short distance and goes straightly to north-wards upto the western boundary corner of Costee plantation done by Soil Conservation Department.
- NORTH: From the north western corner of Coffee plantation (Soil Conservation Department) the boundary goes to east-wards crossing the Aizawl Silchar road. After crossing the said road it follows the stream flowing eastwards upto stream junction, at a distance of 630.00 Metres from the M in Road.
- EAST: Starting from the said stream junction, at a distance of 630.00 Metres from the main road as mentioned above it goes to south-east direction towards the western saddle (i.e. Tum Tlang Kawn) it goes to southwards towards the junction of Bualpui Lui. From this it goes to southwards to meet the Kawnpui—Bukpui kawng, at a distance of 2.25 Km from the main road, western saddle of hillock, south of R. Chem Lui at stream junction—upto Kelsah Lui nearby stream junction, at a distance of 1.50 Km from the main road along the stream. From this it goes straightly to southern direction to meet the first point of Leichat Kawr as mentioned in the first para.
