DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS :

The State Level Selection Committee will make wide publicity inviting nominations from sponsoring agencies which will make recommendations in time to be processed by the Directorate of Industries for submission to the State Level Selection Committee.

The State Level Selection Committee will select five Top Small Scale Entrepreneurs of the year and recommend them in the prescribed form to the Development Commissioner, Small Scale Industries, New Delhi so as to reach latest by the end of July every year. Assessment of the performance of the recommended small scale entrepreneurs will be based on the data/information received concerning the preceding accounting year of the unit. The State Level Selection Committee will make recommendations, on consideration of the following:—

1. Rate of growth as seen from the production, employees, investment and profit.
2. Use and choice of technology.
3. Self-dependence shown during the establishment of the enterprise, background of entrepreneur and partners, his family, previous experience of Industry or Trade etc.

4. Location of the enterprise specially from the point of view of availability of general Services and infrastructural facilities.
5. Product development and quality control.
6. Import substitution and exports.
7. Successful introduction of new products in the Market.
8. Management of the enterprise including inventory management and accounting procedures.
9. General condition of the plant and building and maintenance of machinery etc
10. Employees' Welfare.

DURATION :

The State Level Selection Committee will remain in force for a period of two years from the date of issue of the Notification or until further order which ever is earlier.

FREQUENCY :

The Committee should normally hold a meeting once in a year and in the month of June at a convenient date.

POWERS TO CO-OPT :

The Chairman will be authorised to Co-opt official/ expert of a Government or Quasi Government organisation, to the Committee for any specified meeting.

QUARUM :

Half of the total number of member including the Chairman will form the quorum for any meeting of the Committee. A clear notice of Fifteen days should normally be issued for holding any meeting of the Committee.
