Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to amend the Mizoram Award of Stipends to Students from Mizoram admitted to approved baink Schools Rules, 1980 as approved by the Government of India, Ministry of Education and Culture (Department of Education) vide their letter No. F. 8-3/83-UT. I dated 29. 3. 1984 with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance vide their Dy. No. 3315-0/84-IFB dated 27. 3. 1984, namely:—

- 1. Short Title and Commencement:
  - i) These rules may be called the Mizoram Award of stipend to students from Mizoram admitted to approved Sainik Schools (amendment) rules, 1984.
  - ii) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of Rule 3:—

For rule 3 of the Mizoram (Award of Stipends to students from Mizoram admitted to approved Sainik Schools) Rules, issued in 1980, the following rules shall be substituted, namely.

"3 Amount of stipend:— The amount of stipend awarded to the students under rule 2 shall be as under:

(a) Tuition fees

Rs. 4,800/- per annum

(b) Ciothing allowance

Rs. 600/- per annum for 1st year.

Rs. 300/- per annum for subsequent year.

(c) Pocket money

: Rs. 150/- per annum.

(d) Caution money

Rs. 150/- should be refunded to the Government on completion of the course of study in the Echool and

the amount is to be given only during the first year.

(e) journey expenses from home to School and back at the time of initial admission and subsequently for coming home and returning to School during authorised school vacation, actual second class railway and bus fare plus Rs. 10/- per day will be given for/to journey twice a year.
