Whereas as the result of an Inspection held into the constitution, working and financial condition of the Dinthar Joint Farming Coop. Society Ltd., under Section 61 of Assam Cooperative Societies Act, 1949 (Act I of 1950) I am of opinion that the society ought to be dissolved.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 65 of the Assam Cooperative Societies Act, 1949 (Act I of 1950) extended in Mizoram, I do hereby cancel the registration of the society.

Further, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (i) of Section 66 of the Act I of 1950, I do hereby appoint Shri R.M. Barman, the Liquidator of Cooperative Societies, Lunglei District, Mizoram to be Liquidator of the said society.

All claims against the dissolved society must be submitted to the Liquidator within 2 months of the publication of this notice.
