1. PREAMBLES:

These rules are framed in pursuance of the provisions under Rule I of Section 35- Chapter III of the C.P.W.D. Manual of Volume II for registration of Contractors under Public Works Departments, Mizoram for all construction works under Public Works Department except Electrical and Mechanical works.

2. TITLE:

These rules may be called "THE RULES FOR REGISTRA ION OF CONTRACTORS UNDER PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, MIZORAM" and shall be effective from the date of Publication.

3. CLASSES OF CONTRACTORS:

There will be four classes of Contractors:

- i) Class I-qualified to tender for works of any amount.
- ii) Class II- qualified to tender for works upto Rs. 6.00 lakhs.
- iii) Class III qualified to tender for works, upto Rs. 1.50 lakhs.
- iv) Class IV- qualified to tender for works upto Rs. 50,000/-.

4. REGISTERING AUTHORITY:

- i) Registration of Class I Contractors will be done by Chief Engineer with the approval thief Engineer and all Superintending Engineers.

 (a) For Aizawl District, or
 - (b) For Lunglei and Chhimtuipui districts.
- iii) The area of operation of Class III Contractors will be any two Divisions.
- iv) The area of operation of Class IV Contractors will be one Division under which he is registered.

6. QUALIFICATIONS:

The following qualifications are required to be fulfilled for registration of different classes of Contractors:

- (1) CLASS I
- (a) Contractors desiring registration as Class I Contractor should have satisfactorily executed atleast 3 works of not less than Rs. 3.00,000/-each, at least one of which shall be of building work, and the aggregate value of all works executed should not be less than Rs. 15.00 lakhs.
- (b) The Contractors shall have at least 5 years experience as Class II registered Contractor.
- (c) DIRECT ENTRY: A degree holder in Civil Engineering having a permanent residence in Mizoram with 10 year's experience in the line with sufficient means, organisation and machinery or a firm, the partners of which fulfill the qualifications mentioned in this clause will be qualified for registration as Class I Contractor.

(2) CLASS - II

- (a) Contractors desiring registration as Class II Contractors, should have satisfactorily executed at least 3 works of not less than Rs. 75,000/-each, at least one of which shall be of building work, and the aggregate value of all works executed should not be less than Rs. 4.00 lakhs.
- (b) The Contractors shall have at least 3 years' experience as Class III registered Contractor.
- (c) DIRECT ENTRY: A degree holder in Civil Engineering having a permanent residence in Mizoram or a Diploma holder in Civil Engineering having a permanent residence in Mizoram with 8 years' experience in the line will be eligible for registration as Class II Contractor.

3) CLASS - III:

- (a) Contractor desiring enlistment as Class III Contractor should have satisfactority executed works the aggregate value of which is not less than Rs. 1.0 '. chs.
- (b) The contractor shall have at least 3 years' experience as a Class IV registered Contractor.
- (c) Direct Entry: A Diploma holder in Civil Engineering having a permanent residence in Mizoram will be eligible for registration as Class III Contractor.

4) CLASS - IV:

The Contractor should have sufficient means, organisation and machinery for executing the works. (For registration as Class IV Contractors, a House Fax Clearance Certificate indicating the pass number and approximate value of the House should be produced. In the case of Contractor having house site alloted by the Village Council, the Certificate should be signed by the President of Village Council and countersigned by a Revenue Officer).

7. EARNEST MONEY:

(a) Fixed Earnest Money: All Contractors desiring registration in the above categories of Contractors shall be required to deposit Fixed Earnest Money as shown below:—

This deposit will exempt them from payment of Earnest Money and Security Deposit in individual Contractual works/cases.

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

A deduction of 10% from the running bill will be made in cases where Contractors do not deposit Fixed Combined Earnest Money and Security Deposit.
