## ANNEXURE

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONTROL AND REGULATION OF HAWKERS  
WITHIN AIZAWL TOWN.

1. The hawkers should not keep their goods and handcarts to cause obstruction to the vehicular traffic and the pedestrians.
2. The hawkers shall operate their handcarts and goods only in a place selected by the Sanitation Officer.
3. Each hawker will be given specific area where his hand cart and goods shall be kept. Selection of suitable place shall be made by the Sanitation Officer.
4. The size of table and hand carts to be used by each and every hawker are as prescribes by the Sanitation Officer. Failure to comply with the size prescribed by the Sanitation Officer may entail cancellation of the site allotted to the hawker.
5. The items of edible and other articles can be sold in a particular locality/area, allotted by the Sanitation Officer.
6. Terms of allotment of seats/place will be for a period of one year unless or otherwise reduced by the Sanitation Officer for specific reason.
7. Application for allotments of seats/place for a Hawker shall be submitted to the Sanitation Officer in prescribed form which will be available in the office of the Sanitation Officer. Incomplete applications shall be liable to rejection.
8. No hawkers shall sell any prohibited/unauthorised articles.
9. Sanitation Officer shall be the licensing authority in respect of permits to be issued to the hawkers.
10. Sanitation Officer or his authorised person/persons shall carry out checks on the hawkers and their goods, he shall give necessary instructions to the hawkers.
11. All hawkers shall pay necessary fees annually or monthly which shall be fixed by the Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl.
12. The Sanitation Officer shall have the power to appoint Collector for collecting the fee or he shall have the power to collect such fee through public auction or may devise any other system of payment.
13. Any penalty to be imposed on defaulters shall be decided by the Sanitation Officer in accordance with the appropriate sections provided in the guidelines of the Mizoram Town ( Sanitation ) Rules, 1980 or any other rules/laws being enforced in the Union territory of Mizoram.
