The main jobs of the Committee are :-

- (1) To go into the whole question of identifying the growth centres in accordance with the letter No. 14/15/85-DBA I dated 12.9.85 from the Government of India Ministry of Industry and company Affairs lopment New Delhi, suggest items for infrastructural Development, assess and recommend the quantum of central assistance and other assistance required from the central Government and other financial Institutions and suggest other needed steps for each such district.
- (2) To consider and recommend for nomination by the State Government of a nodal agency for the execution of the Industrial Projects.
- (3) To examine the feasibility reports prepared/got prepared by the State Government for the major, medium and small scale Industries that have scope for establishment and are likely to be established for obtaining the approval of the IDBI and recommending to the Government of India, Ministry of Industry (Department of Industrial Development), Planning Commission etc.
- (4) To consider and recommend to the State Govt./Central Govt. required to be granted for the setting up of the Industries in the No-Industry Districts/Backward Areas of Mizoram.
- (5) To consider any package of measures which may be additionally taken up by the State Government itself to encourage the establishment of Industries in the No-Industry districts/Backward areas of Mizoram.

- (6) To consider how best the Central assistance for infrastructural Development for each such District could be disbursed by the State Government and properly utilised for the purpose.
- (7) To consider any other allied matter related to the Development of Industries in Mizoram
