No. A. 12078/3/82-HMP, the 26th September, 1986. Whereas the National Police Commission in their Fifth Report has recommended that the minimum educational qualification for recruitment of Police constable should be raised to the level of matriculation and that of Sub-Inspector of Police to the level of graduation.

And whereas the said recommendation having been accepted in principle by the Government and having regard to the position obtaining in Mizoram, it is expedient to amend the relevant provision of the Assam Police Manual as applicable to Mizoram prescribing qualifications as recommended by the Commission.

Now, therefore, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of the Union Territory of Mizoram, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 2 of the Police Act 1861 directs that the minimum educational qualification for recruitment of Police constable will be matriculation from a recognised university or High School Leaving Certificate from a recognised Board of School Education or Board of Higher Secondary Education respectively and that the minimum educational qualification for direct recruitment of SI of police be graduation in any discipline from a recognised University as provided in the Assam Police Manual amended in 1980.
