The Governor of Mizoram is pleased to order the creation of New Soil Conservation Division at Hnahthial with its 2 (two) New Soil Conservation Ranges at South Vanlaiphai and Thingsai in addition to its 2 (two) existing Soil Conservation Ranges at Hnahthial and Haulawng.

The Headquarters of this newly created Soil Conservation Division is at Hnahthial and that of the New Soil Conservation Ranges will be at South Vanlaiphai and Thingsai respectively.

The boundary of new Soil Conservation Division at Hnahthial is as follows :

- Northernside : Inter District boundary of Aizawl District and Lunglei District.
- Easternside : Along the Tiau river which its international boundary of India and Burma.
- Southernside : Along the Darzo river which is inter District boundary of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui Districts.
- Westernside : It starts from the junction of Aizawl, Lunglei Inter-District boundary and Tlawng river in the north. Then follows along the Tlawng river and goes upto North of Khankawn (z) Village and meets Mat river. Then the boundary follows along the Mat river upto the junction of Mat river and Darzo river.

The boundary of the Soil Conservation Ranges is as follows :

1. SOUTH VANLAIPHAH SOIL CONSERVATION RANGE.

The Western and Northernside of the boundary line will follow the Tuipui river. In the eastern and Southern side the boundary line will follow the inter-District boundary of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui Districts.

2. THINGSAI SOIL CONSERVATION RANGE :

In the Northernside, the boundary will follow along the inter Districts boundary of Aizawl and Lunglei District. In the Westernside the boundary line will follow along the Tuichang River till it meets Tuipui River. In the Southernside the boundary line starts from the junction of Tiau River and inter District boundary of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui District then follows along the Tuipui River direction till it meet Tuipang River. In the Easternside the boundary follows along Tiau River.

3. HNAHTHIAL SOIL CONSERVATION RANGE (Existing Range)

The area and boundary will be in between the three rivers of Mat, Tuichang and Tuipui in the East and West, in the Northernside, the boundary will be along the Inter District boundary of Aizawl and Lunglei Districts. And in the Southernside the boundary line will follow along the Mat River and Inter District boundary of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui Districts.

4. HAULAWNG SOIL CONSERVATION RANGE (Existing Range)

The area and boundary will be in between two Rivers Tlawng and Mat Rivers in the West and East. In the North and South the boundary area will be the Hnahthial Soil Conservation Division boundary.

This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Deptt. vide their U.O. No. FIN. 2401/87 dt. 8. 2. 88.

Further, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to order the creation of a new Soil Conservation Range at Hnahlan under Soil Conservation Division Aizawl(East).

Its Headquarters will be at Hnahlan as follows :

HNAHLAN SOIL CONSERVATION RANGE :

The boundary line starts from the meeting point of the Inter C.D. Block boundary line of Ngopa and Khawzawl at Tuivang Lui which is also an International boundary line of India and Burma in the Northeastern corner near Khuang-phah Village. Thence, the boundary line follows first Tuimang Lui upstream side Southernly direction and further following River Tiau downstream side Southernly direction and further following River Tiau downstream side, in the same direction upto the meeting point of Inter-Village boundary line of Vapar and Ngur Villages at River Tiau. Thence the boundary line follows the inter-Village boundary line of N.E. Diltlang and Vapar in the North and Ngur in the south and further following wertenly till it meets Tuipui river near North Khawbung. Thence, the boundary line follows river Tuipui downstream side in north westernly direction upto the confluence of river Tuipui and Tampet Lui, again, following Tampet Lui upstream side in northernly direction the boundary line follows the inter-village boundary line of Nurlen and Tualcheng in the east and Rabung and Khuallen in the West till it meets the inter-C.D. Block boundary line of Ngopa and Khawzawl near Pamchung village in the northwestern corner. Finally, the boundary line follows the inter C.D. Block boundary line of Ngopa and Khawzawl in easternly direction till it meets the starting point.

No. A. 12011/2/82-HMP, the 8th February 1988. Whereas the prescribed minimum height for recruitment of Police Constable is 5'3" and chest measurement 31" inches;

And, whereas, the Govt. of Mizoram proposes to raise 2nd Bn MAP to meet the immediate requirement of the Police forces,

And whereas ; it is not possible to get immediately sufficient number of persons with such prescribed height and chest measurement ;

Now, therefore, in order to get sufficient candidates available for screening who are otherwise physically fit for recruitment, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to relax the provision and reduce the requirement of height to 5'2" and chest to 30" for a period of 6 months w.e.f. the date of issue of this order.
