### NOTIFICATION

No. CDC-L/87/1, the 18th September 1987. Pursuant upon the official resolution moved by Sri S. Chakma, Executive member i/c Judicial, and passed by the District Council on 11/9/87, I, Sri D.D. Chakma, Chairman, Chakma District Council declare as follows:-

(1) The existing Judicial Court at Kamalanagar is upgraded to the District Council Court with the Court President and Recorder and two other Judicial Officers. This Court shall be the highest appellate Court of the said District Council and shall have jurisdiction to the hearing and disposal of all appeals preferred from any decision or judgement of a Subordinate District Council Court, or Village Courts and original cases or suits if brought before it and deemed necessary for administration of justice.

(2) The existing Judicial Officer Sri B.L. Dewan who is presiding over the aforesaid Judicial Court shall be the Court President & Recorder of the said District Council Court.
