This capital cost will not be recovered from the beneficiaries.

During the 88-89, 1000 families in 39 villages (Aizawl Dist. 23, Lunglei 12, Chhimtupui Dist. 4 villages) of Mizoram living below the proverty line are to be provided such connections.
