- ix) Holding of fairs and industrial exhibitions, cinema and cinema-tographic exhibition including Video Shows.
- x) Management and control of slaughter-houses within the notified area, regulation of import and slaughtering of pigs, cows, buffaloes, goats, sheep, chicken etc, for sale of meat.
- xi) Disposal of unclaimed deadbodies from the morgue, obnoxious or deceased or unclaimed animals including stray dogs.
- xii) Establishment and maintenance of grazing grounds for cattle.
