Therefore, the Government of Mizoram hereby makes the following rules afresh, namely:—

Short title, 1. (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram State (Grant of extend and Loans for Housing) Rules, 1989.

commencement:

- (2) They shall extend to the towns and sub-towns as may be specified by the State Government by notification in official Gazette for the extension of these rules.
- (3) They shall came into force at once.

- Definations; 2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires;
 - a) "Approved Colony" means a colony for selected or approved construction of a house approved by the technical wing of the Department;
 - b) "Construction" means construction of a new house and includes reconstruction of an existing house;
 - c) "Department" means the Local Administration Department;
 - d) "Government" means the State Government of Mizoram;
 - e) "income" of the applicant in this behalf will be the income as assessed for the purpose of income tax;
 - f) "Loan" means an advance granted on condition of repayment with interest accrued thereon;
 - g) "Official Gazette" means the Mizoram Gazette.
- Kinds of loan: 3. There shall be granted two kinds of loan under these rules, namely:—
 - (a) Middle Income Group Loan, and
 - (b) Low Income Group Loan.

Amount of loan:

- 4. The amount of loans to be granted for a house shall be determined on the following basis:—
 - (1) Under the Middle Income Group Housing Scheme as may be fixed by the Govt. of Mizzram from time to time.
 - (2) Under the Low Income Group Housing Schene, as may be fixed by the Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

Constitution of Advisory Committee:

- 5. (1) The Govt. may constitute an Advisory Committee consisting of five members or more to scrutinise all applications for loan under the scheme and to recommend names of the applicants for receiving of loan applied for keeping in view the repaying capacity of the applicant and other connected factors such as specifications, designs and the estimates of the house proposed to be built, availability of essential services in accordance with the standards normally applicable to the area in which the house is proposed to be built in that area.
 - (2) The members of the Advisory Committee under sub-rule (1) are —
 - (1) Chairman
 - (2) Member (3) — Member
 - (4) Member
 - (5) Member Secy.

Mode of appli- 6. Application for the grant of loan under these rules shall be cation: submitted in the prescribed Form as Annexure-I to be obtained from the Department on payment of five rupees for each Form together with the Income Certificate duly certified by the Superintendent of Taxes in other cases and also Income Tax Clearance Certificate in case of those applicants who are paying

grant of loan:

Eligibility for 7. (1) The Middle Income Group loan or the Low Income Group loan as the case may be under these rules may be granted by the Government to the applicants for construction of a house required for the bona-fide residence of such applicants within the territorial limit of such towns or sub-towns whose monthly income is not less than Rs. 1501 but not exceeding Rs- 2500 only for Middle Income Group and less than Rs. 1501 for Low Income Group.

> Provided that the Government may, by a Notification published in the official Gazette, revise the income limit from time to time. and the second of the second

EXPLANATION:

Income Tax.

For the purpose of sub-rule (1) the total annual income. of the applicant shall not include the income of any other member of his/her family.

- (2) Not withstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1), the Government may sanction loan to the applicant for the purchase of ready built house.
- (3) No assistance shall be admissible towards cost of land ànd/or construction of a house in a colony in which the layout, etc. have not been approved by the competent authority, that is to say, loan assistance under these rules shall be restricted to holders of plots in approved colonies only.
- (4) The plot of land in which the house is proposed to be build must be duly settled under the Mizo District (Land & Revenue) Act, 1956.
- (5) No loan assistance shall be granted in those cases where construction of the house has been commenced before the loan is sanctioned by the Government.
 - (6) The Government may relax the provision of sub-rule (1), on exceptional cases where the Government is satisfied that the house proposed to be built under these rules is required for the bogafide residence of the applicant and that it will not be possible for the applicant to reside in his existing house

for reasons other than of its having already been let out on rent or being situated at a place other than the place of his work or business.

Security:

- 8. (a) The loanee shall mortgage the plot of land, together with the house to be built thereon, with the Government as security for the repayment of loan. He shall also furnish sufficient collateral security approved and acceptable to the Government of the surety of a suitable person for the amount of loan, which shall be discharged immediately on the completion of process of the Control of the State of the the house.
 - (b) The Government may at their discretion require the applicant to furnish additional security where considered necessary ordinarily, the security as in clause(a) above shall be deemed to be sufficient.

Condition regarding construction:

9. The house to be constructed with the loan under these rules shall conform to the building Plans and Estimates approved by the Technical Wing of the Department and it shall be completed within one year from the date the first instalment of such loan is disbursed to be borrower.

Sanctioning Authority:

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10. The power of sanctioning the loan under these rules including power to reject the application and to cancell or revise the sanction shall vest with Government in the Department of Local Administration.

of loan:

- Disbursement 11. A loan sanctioned under these rules shall be disbursed to the borrower in three instalments according to the progress of the work as shown in the following, namely:
 - a) First instalment, the amount of which shall be forty per cent of the total sanctioned amount on execution of a mortgage deed by the borrower;
 - b) Second instalment, the amount of which shall be forty per cent of the total sanctioned amount on completion of the plinth level; and
 - c) The third instalment, the amount of which shall be twenty percent of the sanctioned amount on completion of the roof level and such completion of the plint level or roof level shall be countersigned by the technical wing of the Department.

Insurance:

The house so constructed with the loan under these rules shall 12. be insured to any insurance company in the vicinity of the locality of which such house is constructed for the amount assessed as the value of the house against damage and destruction by fire, earthquake, flood, storm, landslide, bomb explosion or any other natural calamities within four months

from the date of completion of the house and the policy must be assigned to the Director Local Administration Department of the Government of Mizoram.

Interest:

13. The loan will carry interest from the date on which it is advanced. The rate of interest on the loan disbursed under the scheme will be determined by the Govt. at the time of its disbursement, and is likely to be in the neighbourhood of 5 1/2%. Different instalments of the loan are liable to carry different rates of interest.

Recovery of loan:

14. The repayment of the loan with interest shall be made in annual equated instalments not exceeding 25(twenty five) instalment. It will however, be open to the loanee to repay the loan in a shorter period, if he so desires.

Summary recovery:

15. If the loan or any part thereof advanced under these rules is used by the borrower for any purpose other than that for which the loan in granted or if the house constructed with the loan is let out on rent or used for any purpose other than for the residence of the borrower of any default in repayment of the loan or in case of default to comply with any of these rules, the whole amount of the loan advanced together with interest thereon shall at once become due and recoverable from the borrower.

Repeal and Savings

16. On and from the date these rules are finally approved by competent authority the existing rules published in 1976 shall stand repealed.

Notwithstanding such repeal, any action taken or purported have been taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been taken under these rules.
