EASTERN SIDE : The boundary line runs from B.P. No 1 towards east and then along Biате to Lungdar road 200m (H) away from the road. B.P. No. 2 is fixed at 23deg. 13' 49" lat. and 93deg. 6' 32" long. From B.P. No 2 the line runs 200m (H) below the road upto the depression below Ralvenkawn. From which the line turns towards Palunglawn just 200m below the old road. B.P. No 3 is then fixed at 23deg. 12' 09" lat. and 93deg. 6' 03" long. which is below Palungkawn (eastern side). The line then run east direction 200m(H) below Khawbung road and B.P. CLASSIFICATION OF LAND WITHIN THE SPECIFIED TOWN AREA OF LUNG DAR

1st GRADE : Both side of the main road within the perpendicular distance of 100ft. or 30.48m (horizontally) from the side edge of the road subjected to those sites which are having frontage or return-frontage to the road only as :—

1. From the junction of main road (Lungdar-to-Biate) and circular road along the main road upto the Memorial Pillar of Kristian Lalbiaka Hnamte near playing ground.

2ND GRADE : Both sides of the main road/street within the perpendicular distance of 100ft. or 30.48m (Horizontally) from the side of the road/street subjected to those sites which are having frontage/return frontage to the side of the road/street only of all the Truckable or Jeepable road which are not included in the 1st grade within the specified town area.

3RD GRADE : All land which are not included in the first and second grades within the specified town area.

In exercise of powers conferred under Rule 20 of Delegation of financial Power Rules, 1978 the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following Rules, namely :

1. SHORT TITLE :—

These Rules may be called MIZORAM INDUSTRIAL PROMOTION (Stipendiary) TRAINING RULES-1988. These Rules shall govern the system of selection of trainees and awarding stipends, and terms and conditions of selection of trainees selected for training both inside Mizoram by the Industries Department, Government of Mizoram.

2. COMMENCEMENT :—

These Rules shall come into force with immediate effect.

3. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES :—

(a) To ensure availability of skilled workers and technically qualified personnel in the Department, in the departmental Projects and in the private sectors.

(b) To up-date technical know how of the skilled work in the Department, in the departmental Projects and in the private sectors from time to time so as to ensure quality production and production efficiency.

(c) To reduce unemployment amongst the local youths and entrepreneurs by encouraging them to take up self employment in any line of Industries.

4. SCOPE :—

The various training envisaged under these rules shall include :—

- (a) Post graduate studies in any Scientific and technical lines which are required in the Department of Industries, Industrial Projects and Government aided projects and bodies, in and outside Mizoram.
- (b) Degree, Diploma and Certificate courses in different scientific and technical studies which are required in the Department or in any Government undertaking or in a Government sponsored bodies or Projects in and outside Mizoram.
- (c) Various artisans training in different Industrial trades or courses in and outside Mizoram.
- (d) In-service training by sending departmental personnel for any Industrial trades or purposes, or for courses in Industrial and technical lines which are required by the Department of Industries in and outside Mizoram.
- (e) Sending of trainees for experience training, in any technical line or trades from amongst the in service personnel or from amongst public entrepreneurs or artisans in and outside Mizoram.

5. ELIGIBILITY :—

Various training mentioned in section 4 above, shall depend on qualifications prescribed for the course by the authorities concerned for a particular course or training.

However, the following categories of persons shall not be eligible for any such training under these rules if he/she is :—

- (a) Minor
- (b) Having cases in Criminal Courts
- (c) Mentally insane
- (d) Non-resident of Mizoram or if he/she is not permanently based in Mizoram.

5. A—

CONDITION OF ELIGIBILITY.

- (a) Eligibility for seats and stipends for prosecution of training mentioned in sec. 4 shall depend on fulfilment of the terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Governor from time to time for various branches of technical studies.

- (b) A stipend holder under these Rules shall not hold any other scholarship/stipend. If awarded a merit scholarship or any other scholarship/stipend, the student may exercise his/her option for either of those two scholarship/stipends which ever is beneficial to him/her and shall inform the Government through the Head of the Institution the option to make. No stipend shall be paid to the student under these Rules from the date he/she accepts another scholarship/stipend.

A student may, however be paid a grant or monetary help from the Government of any other source for the purchase of book or Equipment in addition to the stipend paid under these Rules.

- (c) The stipend is dependent on the satisfactory progress and conduct of the student. If it is reported by the Head of Institution at any time that a student has by reasons of his/her own act or default failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of misconduct such as resorting to or participating in strikes, irregularity in attendance without permission of the authorities concerned etc. the Governor may stop or withhold further payment of the stipend for such period as it may think fit.
- (d) If a candidate is found to have obtained a stipend by false statements, his/her stipend will be cancelled forthwith and the amount paid will be recovered at the discretion of the Administrator.
- (e) A stipend may be stopped if the stipend holder changes the subjects of the course of study for which the stipend was originally granted or changes the Institution of study without the prior approval of the Governor. The head of the Institution shall report of such cases to the Government and stop payment of the stipend amount. The amount paid may also be recovered at the discretion of the Governor.

MODE OF SELECTION BOARD

Selection of trainee shall be of two tier system.

- (a) For the selection of trainees for higher discipline Graduate level and the selection Board shall consist of :—
- (i) Secretary, Industries — Chairman
 - (ii) Director of Industries — Member Secretary.
 - (iii) One representative from Finance Department.
 - (iv) A Co-opted member from District Offices (to be nominated by the Chairman).
- (b) For the selection of artisans training and for courses upto graduate level, the Selection Board shall consist of :—
- (i) Director of Industries — Chairman
 - (ii) Jt. Director of Industries — Member Secretary
 - (iii) Scheme officer concerned — Member
 - (iv) A Co-opted member from District Offices (To be nominated by the Chairman).

7. DURATION OF TRAINING

Duration of training for various courses of training shall depend on official prescription of training by concerned authorities. In case a candidate fails to complete the courses in time genuine grounds he/she may be allowed extension of training as deemed fit by the sponsoring authorities.

8. RATE OF STIPEND :

The rate of stipend and book grant for various courses of training shall be as follows ;---

- (a) For post Graduate courses Rs. 1000/-p.m. tenable for two years. In case of failure half the amount of stipend shall be paid to the trainee for a period of 12 months for the 3rd year. Travelling Allowances and other grants shall also be admissible for him for one extra year.

A trainee shall be entitled to a second class Bus/Rail fare from and to place of Institution once in an academic year. A trainee shall also be entitled to extra sanctions of a lumpsum grant of Rs. 2000/-p.a. by way of book grant during the period of training. He/she shall also be entitled to have reimbursement of actual train fare (Second class) Bus fare for the period of tour duty certified by the Head of Institution (Provided the tour was undertaken as officially compulsory and no expenditure is borne by the institution concerned).

- (b) For a graduate or equivalent course the rate of stipend shall be Rs. 500/- per month tenable for a duration of the academic years prescribed for that course extendable for one extra year in case of failure. But he shall only be paid stipend half the normal amount for that extra year.

A trainee shall be entitled to second class Rail/Bus fare from and to the place of Institution once in an academic year. A trainee shall also be entitled to extra sanction of lumpsum grant of Rs. 1500/-p.a. by way of Book grant during the period of training. He/She shall also be entitled to have reimbursement of actual train fare (Second class)/Bus fare for the period of tour provided that the tour was undertaken as officially compulsory and no expenditure is borne by the institution concerned.

- (c) For Diploma course, the rate of stipend shall be Rs. 350/- per month tenable for a duration of the academic years prescribed for the course, extendable for one extra year in case of failure. But he/she shall only be paid stipend half the normal amount for that extra year.

A trainee shall be entitled to second class train fare/Bus fare from and to the place of institution once in an academic year. A trainee shall also be entitled to a lumpsum amount of Rs. 800/- per annum for book grant during the period of training. He/She shall also be entitled to have reimbursement of actual train fare (second class) Bus fare for the period of tour provided the tour was undertaken as officially compulsory and no expenditure is borne by the institution concerned.

- (d) For artisan course, the rate of stipend shall be Rs. 250/-p.m. A lump sum of Rs. 300/- may be given for the book grant if necessary. They shall be entitled to T.A. at the rate of second class rail fare or Bus fare (ordinary) from and to their place of training once in an academic year.

All other incidental expenditure, directly concerned with the training, may be reimbursed only after the Director of Industries has satisfied himself that the expenditure is genuine, reasonable and compulsory for the successful completion of the training.

9. PAYMENT :-

- (a) The stipend to the students shall be payable from the month of his/her joining the course of study to the month in which the final examination is completed.
- (b) The stipend shall be payable to students studying courses including summer/winter vacation falling their course of study.
- (c) The amount of stipend due in respect of the student shall be paid to the student shall be paid to the student concerned.
- (d) In the case of the death of student, the amount of stipends due to him/her upto the end of the month the student has attended the Institution shall be paid to the parents Guardian/Legal heir of the student through the Head of Institution.

10. BOND AND SECURITY :—

An entrepreneur/trainee selected by the Board for any training course must execute Bond of Security as prescribed by the Department (See Annexure I).

11. REFUND OF STIPEND :—

If any trainee drops out without completing his training course on a flimsy and unreasonable ground and without the permission of the Director of Industries, he shall refund the whole amount already paid by the Department in connection with his/her training.

12. MEDICAL FACILITIES :—

If a trainee during the course of his training is hospitalised, the actual expenses shall be re-imburseable on the basis of hospital expenditure statement issued by the head of the Department of that hospital. Hospitalisation re-imburement is permissible only when a trainee is hospitalised in a Government hospital or Government sponsored hospital or Government recognised hospital for public (not private hospital or clinics).

13. RESIDUARY PROVISION :—

Anything or issues connected with training under this rules, which are provided in this rules, shall be settled by the Industries Department in conformity with any other relevant rules or provisions in force, under the Government of Mizoram.
