It is hereby notified for general information that the appointments of those named persons to continue as Village Council Members in respect of (1) Hnahlan (2) Biate (3) Khawbung (4) Ngopa (5) Suangpuitawa (6) Ramhlan (7) Sairang (8) Phuaibuang (9) Lungdai (10) S. Chaltlang (11) Tlungzel (12) Serchhip (13) Lungdar 'W' (14) Chhahltlang (15) Ruallung (16) Bungtlang (17) Zote (18) Champhai (19) Raantlang villages pending the decision of the Court in cases filed against the orders of dissolution of these Village Council by the Executive Committee of the erstwhile Mizo District Council, in an order under the signature of the Rural Administrative Officer, Conveyed under Memo No. EK. 4/72/341 dated 5th. May, 1972 is cancelled with immediate effect.

In the interest of general public, however, it is hereby ordered that fresh elections to the Village Councils named above will be held as soon as possible as provided under Section 25 (2) of the Lushai Hills District (Village Councils) Act, 1953. Similarly the fresh elections in respect of all those Village Councils whose members had resigned or otherwise consequent to which village Administration is carried on by the CAs, will also be held at the same time.
