In pursuance of the recommendation of the Tenth Finance Commission the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to set up a Calamity Relief Fund for the State of Mizoram for meeting all relief expenditure on Natural Calamities. This fund will be in existence separate from the General Revenue of the State and contributions to this fund will be made by the Central and the State of Mizoram in the proportion laid down by the Tenth Finance Commission. The fund will be kept in the State Bank of India, Aizawl and will be administered by the State Level Committee.

2. Contribution to the fund by the Government of India and the State Govt. will be as follows:—

3. In respect of State Government's share of expenditure provision of fund will be made in the State Budget and the amount required from time to time shall be got sanctioned for deposit into the Bank account.

- 4. Following the creation of the fund, all expenditure arising out of Natural Calamities shall be met from out of this fund. The yearly addition to the fund as well as the accrual of interest thereon shall be used to meet the requirement.
- 5. The money put into the fund in a year and remaining unspent in that year or in the subsequent years would be available to the State at the end of the fifth year or thereafter for being used as a resource for the next plan.
- 6. Further, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to constitute a State Level Committee headed by the Chief Secretary of the State Government of Mizoram to operate the fund.
