- 3. The available assets viz: buildings etc. may be utilised by the lease who will be responsible for maintenance of the same thereafter. However, he will not be the owner of the such assets. Any alteration and renovation, extension without the prior approval of the Government is not allowed.
- 4. The society/individual who is allotted is required to give his/her activitities when called for.
- 5. Transfer of the land from one person to another person is illegal unless approval is obtained from the Department.
