No.A.46011/1/2004-GAD, the 22nd November, 2005. The entire business of the Govt. of Mizoram is transacted in all concerned departments specified in the First Schedule under Rule 3 of Govt. of Mizoram (Transaction of Business) Rules, 1987, within their respective subjects allocated to them by the authority under Rule 3 of Govt. of Mizoram (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1987 vide Schedules thereof.

As per Entry 22 of subjects under XI Schedule Rules 3 under Govt. of Mizoram (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1987, allotment of subjects to those 39 Departments included in the First Schedule of Rule 3 under Govt. of Mizoram (Transaction of Business) Rules, 1987, creation, reorganization and amalgamation of Departments are the subject matters of General Administration Department.

In the recent past, arbitrary executive orders are noticed to have been issued at several occasions by certain Departments effecting their re-organization of Departments, Directorates, Circles, Divisions, etc., without obtaining approval of General Administration Department. Such Orders have no legal standing, as they were not issued in the authority of Govt. of Mizoram (Transaction of Business/Allocation of Business) Rules, 1987. The designated posts thereof and the reorganized/amalgamated Departments altogether are treated as illegal (authority) unless ex-post facto approval of GAD to that effect is obtained. Such departments shall submit ex-post facto proposal for bifurcation/trifurcation etc., within November, 2005 positively.

It is reiterated that in future all Departments shall obtain approval of GAD in the event of any such necessity for re-organization (bifurcation/trifurcation) and amalgamation of Departments.

This supersedes the earlier O.M. of even No. dated 7.11.2005.
