6. Medical Facilities on the pattern of member of Mizoram Legislative Assembly plus Medical Allowance @ Rs. 100/-per month per Judicial Officer.
7. Leave Travel Concession (LTC) once in four years, Home Town Travel concession (HTC) once in two years.
8. In respect of Special Pay the order of Hon'ble Gauhati High Court will govern.
9. Concurrent Charge Allowance @ 10% of minimum time scale of the additional post held.
10. Encashment of Leave and Leave Salary as per CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972 and encashment of leave not exceeding one month pay in a block of two years which shall be tax free.
11. Transfer Grant an Amount equal to one month basic pay.
