NOTIFICATIONS

No. G. 28014/11/2004-AGR, the 16th May, 2006. The Governor of Mizoram is pleased to issue Revised Guidelines of Mizoram Intodelhna Programme with immediate effect and until further orders as stated below.

REVISED GUIDELINES ON MIZORAM INTODELHNA PROGRAM (MIP):

I. MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM:

- a) To propagate against shifting cultivation practice among the farming population especially the jhumia community of the State.
- b) To encourage settled and permanent farming through commercialization of Agriculture, Horticulture, etc:
- c) To facilitate farm productivity through need-based programming which would include provision for critical inputs e.g. water harvesting, irrigation, project area connectivity and land development activity etc.
- d) To programme for a cluster-based crop production and to facilitate buy-back networking and processing points.
- e) To frame an action plan for optimal tapping of existing potential cash crops and horticulture crops e.g. passion fruit, grapes etc. through specially focused programs as well as through public private partnership (PPP) etc.
- f) To ensure that market is assured for each of the project-based activity on selected crop and that such market would address the supply needs within the State, as well as of the national and international market demands.
- g) To provide for gap filling funds which would be in the nature of direct financing of unmet needs and critical plan gaps through funds provision made under state plan, and by way of making provision as state's share to various centrally sponsored scheme sources etc. including credit-linked programs and schemes;

- h) To formulate vital policy-imparting wish list with a view to facilitate the outflow of products from the state. viz Border trade routes up-gradation of existing nationwide communication systems e.g. Railways-from narrow to broad gauge etc. Besides to also seek to effect measures to reduce power tariff in the Agriculture sector and to suggest for crucial incentives to enhance productivity and reduce production costs.

I. PROGRAM MODALITIES.

- 1) The MIP will primarily be a think tank and program formulator. It would not be involved in the direct execution of projects and programs elements.
- 2) MIP would however outsource the work implementation through the appropriate Line Department with whom the program elements and action planning would be drawn up. It will therefore rely on the existing men, material and management with the line department in the implementation and actual execution of the various programmed activities and projects.
- 3) The core beneficiaries of the programmed activities would be the small and marginal farmers either organized through self help group units or through crop
While the beneficiary groups would be encouraged to voluntarily organize themselves into interest groups, MIP will not insist on the formation nor shall it be monetarily or otherwise programmed to assist such societies of association.
- 4) The Program Action Plan would comprise of detailed crop, area/cluster selection and the size of beneficiaries based on the resource in hand. The plan shall be complete with detailed project-cost estimation, duration and impact assessment.
- 5) One of the most vital role of MIP will be that of monitoring & evaluation.
 - * Monitoring activity would be carried out through their assigned program functionaries AND the assigned responsibility Centres. The task of data collection especially primary data (i.e. field based data) could be outsourced through reliable Community Based Organization (CBOs) etc.
 - * Independent and comprehensive Evaluators too shall be outsourced. The result of these evaluations would serve as important feedback on performance review by the Implementing Agencies and a rich source for lessons learnt and program refinement.
- 6) The MIP shall therefore play a vital role in identifying and meeting the unmet needs and critical gaps in the planned activities of the state in the field of Agriculture and allied sector leading to self sustenance (intodelhna) at the individual farmer and grass root community levels. It would be focused on convergence planning and programming and shall be the nodal body through which gap-filling grants would be channelized.

- 7) Central to the Intodelhna program would be the market oriented approach. Market search and research would constitute the core activity of the MIP. It would serve a catalytic role in facilitating the vital market link to the programmed production;
- 8) The MIP shall be actively involved in outsourcing expertise through either individual or institutional consultancy for purposes like Detail Project Report formulation of for specific tasks which may relate to execution modalities of for monitoring an evaluation;
- 9) Besides the above, fund under MIP shall be converged to fill in gaps in existing and ongoing programs. For example connectivity and land development component etc. under MIP could be 'contributed' to these programs.

THE APEX COMMITTEE ON PROGRAMS.

- 10) An apex Committee on Programs chaired by the Chief Minister would be responsible for considering and according approval to programmed activities formulated by the MIP.

The MIP Committee shall composite of :

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| (i) Chairman | — Chief Minister |
| (ii) Vice-Chairman | — Minister (Agriculture) |
| (iii) Member Secretary | — Chief Secretary |
| (iv) Assistant Member Secretary | — Commissioner (Agri. etc) |
| (v) Other Members notified by government | from time to time. |

- 11) MIP SUB-COMMITTEES : Besides the above, TWO Sub-Committees, viz Marketing Sub-Committee and the other Program Evaluation and Monitoring Sub-Committee shall be notified by Government.

THE MIP ESTABLISHMENT.

- 12) The Mizoram Intodelhna Program establishment will function as a separate Cell in the precincts of the Directorate of Agriculture, Government of Mizoram. The Cell shall be administratively supervised by the Programme Director designate.

SOURCES OF FUNDS.

- 13) Funds channelized to MIP are mainly in the form of Grant-in-Aid. However, the component of grants may be constituted of Normal Central Assistance source as well as Additional Central Assistance (ACA) and Loan source etc.
- 14) This replaces the earlier MIP Guidelines.
