**NOTIFICATIONS****ORDERS BY THE ADMINISTRATOR**

No. MC. 4/15/72, the 1st. March, 1974. Whereas unlawful gangs are moving about in Mizoram to create disorder and disturb the peace and tranquility there.

And whereas the Administrator of Mizoram after careful consideration of all facts and circumstances is satisfied that in order to make adequate provision for the suppression of the disorder and maintenance of the public order and communications in the disturbed area and for the protection of life and property of the loyal citizens therein, it is necessary to declare the whole of the Union Territory of Mizoram as disturbed area.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Assam Disturbed Area Act, 1955 (Assam Act XIX of 1955), the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare the whole of the Union Territory of Mizoram as disturbed area under the said act for a period of six months.

**ORDERS BY THE ADMINISTRATOR**

No. MC. 4/15/72, the 1st. March, 1974. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of the section 10 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act 1932 (Act No. 23 of 1932), the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to declare that all offences punishable under sections 186, 188, 189, 190, 228, 295—A, 298, 505, 506 and 507 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Act No. 45 of 1860), when committed in the area specified below, shall notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (Act No. 5 of 1898), be cognisable.

This notification shall remain in force for a period of six months.
