ADVERTISEMENT

No. DE. 4(1-38)73/37, the 3rd. April, 1974. Applications in plain paper are invited from bonafide students who are permanent resident of Mizoram and prosecuting Post-Matric courses in recognised institutions in India for award of Book Grants during the current academic session.

ELIGIBILITY :

- (i) To be eligible for consideration for award of the book grant, a student should maintain (a) an average attendance of at least 60% of all the lectures, (in case of non-availability of attendance records, a certificate of good-attendance from the Head of Institution/Department should be produced), (b) a good moral character and conduct as certified by the Head of institution wherein he/she is studying ;
- (ii) He/She should produce a certificate of satisfactory progress of studies from the Head of the Institution or Head of Department in case of Post-Graduate students ;

- (iii) He/She should not be a regular employee of any Government or Non-Government establishment organization such as aided schools/offices etc. drawing a monthly basic pay of Rs. 75/- or above ;
- (iv) Monthly joint income from all sources of his/her parents should not exceed Rs. 1,000/- which should be certified by a Gazetted Officer ;
- (v) He/She should not be a repeater in any class in the current session;
- (vi) He/She should not be a recipient of any scholarship/stipend from State Government/Government of India or any other established organizations such as UGC, NCERT, ICAR, etc. except the Govt. of India post-matric scholarship for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes students.

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS:

The application should contain full name (in block capital letters), father's name, permanent Home Address, Age, class, course of study, name of Institution, allotment number of the Post-Matric Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes scholarship for 1973-74, and other relevant information, necessary certificates, and supportive documents should be submitted through the Head of the Institution attended by the student or the Secretary, University Classes in case of Post-Graduate students.

Applications should be sent to the Secretary, Mizoram Scholarship Board, Aizawl by Registered post acknowledgement due and will be received by him till the 15th of May, 1974, after which date no application will be entertained.
