**NOTICE**

MAP/B/105/73/134, the 23rd. April 1974. Under sub-section (2) of section 64 of the N.E.A.R. Act, 1971 read with the proviso thereunder, it is essential for the Central Government to issue orders in respect of such persons serving in connection with the affairs of existing state of Assam and were posted in the erstwhile Mizo District on or before the appointed day whose services are required in connection with the administration of Union Territory Mizoram so that such persons be deemed to have been allocated to the Union Territory w.e.f. such dates as may be specified in the order by the Central Govt.

In order to facilitate issue of such an order or orders the Government of Mizoram had decided :—

- (1) That for the above purpose the status of the person be determined on the basis of the post held by him on 20. 1. 72 i.e. just before the appointed day.
- (2) That such person who were not borne on Assam Cadre but recruited against post sanctioned by Government of Assam for the Mizo Hills District will be allocated enblock.

(3) That persons who are borne on Assam cadre and were thus transferable outside Mizo District be broadly divided into two categories namely :—

(1) Those who are permanent resident of Mizoram and (2) Those who are permanent resident of places outside Mizoram. In respect of persons of category (1) It is presumed that they are interested in their allocation to Mizoram and action will be taken by the Government accordingly. In respect of persons belonging to second category they are hereby directed to exercise their option within a period of one month from the date of issue of this Notice indicating their willingness in favour of allocation in the proforma enclosed.

In the interest of service it has also been decided that such option referred to above may be sent by the person concerned direct to the Chief Secretary to Government of Mizoram in the Appointment Department along with a copy to his Heads of Department. In case no such willingness is received within the period of one month it will be presumed that the concerned official wants to revert back to the Govt. of Assam.
