No. ESS. 72/74/2, the 29th. May, 1974. The Lt. Governor of Mizoram is pleased to order:—

- a) that Headquarters of one of the three existing Deputy Directors of Education shall be at Lunglei with effect from 18th. June 1974 and until further orders,
- b) that Shri Hranthanga, Deputy Director of Education, Aizawl shall move to Lunglei immediately to hold charge of the Office of the Deputy Director of Education at Lunglei.
- c) that Shri Hranthanga, Deputy Director of Education shall perform

the duties of Inspector of School for the districts of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui, exercising all powers delegated to the Inspector of Schools vide Government of Mizoram, Finance Department order No. FE. 2/72/PT dated 11th. July, 1973 Schedule III.

- d) that consequent to the issue of this order the present Office of the Assistant Inspector of Schools at Lunglei shall stand merged with the newly set up Office of the Deputy Director of Education, Lunglei, functioning as Inspector of Schools for the districts of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui with effect from the date Shri Hranghanga, Deputy Director of Education starts functioning at Lunglei and that as such, the present separate Office of the Assistant Inspector of Schools, Lunglei shall cease to exist as a separate Office and the same with all the Staff etc., shall stand merged with the Office of the Deputy Director of Education, Lunglei functioning as Inspector of

Schools for Lunglei and Chhimtuipui,

- e) that the jurisdiction of the existing Inspector of Schools, Aizawl shall be limited to the district of Aizawl only whereas the Deputy Director of Education, Lunglei acting as Inspector of Schools for the districts of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui, shall have jurisdiction over all Schools in the districts of Lunglei and Chhimtuipui.
- f) that the present Assistant Inspector of Schools, Lunglei, the two Deputy Inspector of Schools at Lunglei and Chhimtuipui with all the Sub-Inspectors and Assistant Sub-Inspectors of Schools under them will be under the control of the Deputy Director of Education at Lunglei functioning as Inspector of Schools for Lunglei and Chhimtuipui.

ADVERTISEMENT

No. DE. 1 (1-4)/74/14-A, the 27th. May, 1974. Applications are invited from bona-fide citizens of India for the post of District Social Welfare Officer, Mizoram, in the Scale of pay of Rs. 300-20-400-(EB)-25-550-(EB)-25-800/- p.m. plus all other allowances as admissible from time to time in Mizoram.

2. Candidates must be graduate with Post-Graduate degree or equivalent diploma in Social Welfare Administration from any recognised University/Institution and should not be more than 35 years of age on 1.1.74. The age limit is relaxable to the extent of five years in the case of Schedule Caste/Tribe Candidate. Preferably the candidates should have a worknig knowledge of Mizo language and some experience in the field of Social Welfare.

3. Candidates should submit their applications on plain paper, detailing fully their academic, professional and service experiences. They should also state clearly the division/class obtained by them in the various public examinations from matriculation upward.

4. Applications must be accompanied by a Treasury Chalan of Rs. 5/- (Rs. 2.50 for Scheduled Castes/Tribes and for Political Sufferers and War Service personnel) deposited in the Treasury under the head "XXI Misc. Deptt. Examination Fee-Receipt of the Government of Mizoram." Fees are not refundable and no Postal or Money Orders or stamps will be accepted in lieu of a Treasury Chalan.

Applications without such Chalan will be summarily rejected.

5. Candidates will have to appear for interview before the Selection Board at Aizawl, Mizoram at their own expenses. Date and venue of the interview will be notified in due course.

6. The application should reach the undersigned on or before 15.6.1974.

7. Serving candidates should apply through proper channel.

8. Canvassing directly or indirectly will disqualify a candidate.
