FOR. 15-A/74/81, the 20th January 1977. In exercise of the power conferred under Section 18 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, the Lt. Governor (Administrator) of Mizoram is pleased to declare the areas described as under as Wild Life Sanctuary, Hunting, Shooting, Killing, injury, capturing, poisoning killing with explosive, snaring, Trapping of any wild animal, grazing of domestic animals, setting fires, clearing or felling of any vegetation and collection of any artifacts therefrom are strictly prohibited inside the sanctuary.

The Sanctuary will be named "DAMPA WILD LIFE SANCTUARY"
BOUNDARIES OF DAMPA WILD LIFE SANCTUARY AREA : 180 Sq. MI.
NORTH : Starting from the source of Phuldungsei Tuikhurlui (Tuipui Source) the boundary follows Tuipui downstream till it meets the Kundalui, thence it follows the Kundalui upstream and then takes its turn along Tuivamit upstream, and crosses the inter village footpath of Bunghmun and Serhmun villages at Lungdawkawn. Thence it follows Chhekinlui downstream upto its mouth to Sengmatawk river. Thence follows the Sengmatawk river downstream upto the Teirei river.

EAST : From the mouth of the Sengmatawk river, the boundary follows the Teirei river upstream upto the source, and thence runs straight southward crossing

the saddle from which the rivers, Teirei and Mar raises their sources, till it meets the Mar river at its source, Thence follows the Mar river downstream upto the mouth of a small stream which comes out from the northern side of Vaisam tlang (Vaisam peak).

SOUTH : Thence the boundary runs straight towards west following the above stream and crosses inter village footpath of Phuldungsei and Saithah. Thence it follows another stream downward upto the Keisalam river
Keisalam river downstream upto the Tuilianpui River (or Sazeklui).

WEST : From the mouth of Keisalam river the boundary follows the Tuilianpui (or Sazek) river upstream till it reaches the mouth of Kawrthindeng stream and then follows the Kawrthindeng upstream till it reaches the source of Theichanglui. Then it follows Theichanglui downstream upto the point where the Theichanglui stream meets Sazek (about 2 miles north of Tuipuibari) and thence goes direct west till it meets the trijunction of Bangladesh, Tripura and Mizoram and then follows the interstate boundary between Mizoram and Tripura direct due North upto Phuldungsei village meeting the source of Phuldungsei Tuikhurlui (i.e. Tuipui source).

Applications are invited from bonafide citizens of India, for filling up the following temporary posts under the Education Department, Govt. of Mizoram in the pay scales as noted against each plus other allowances as admissible from time to time under the Rules.

- (1) Lecturer in Geography in the scale of Rs. 700-40-900-EB-40-1100-50-1300/- p.m. (one post)

1st Class Master's Degree holder or 2nd Class Master's Degree holder with Honours at degree level in the subject concerned. Previous experience of teaching in a Degree College and/or Specialisation in Cartography shall be considered desirable qualifications.

- (2) Lecturer in Mizoram Institute of Education in the pay scale of Rs. 700-40-900-EB-40-1100-50-1300/- p.m. (one post).

Candidate should be at least a Master's Degree holder with a B. Ed. B. Ed or an M. Ed/M.A (Edn) with a first class degree in either and at least a Second Class degree in the other, and with Honours in the First Degree Examination plus at least 3 years teaching experience in an recognised High School or at least 2 years teaching experience in Teachers Training Institution or 2 years experience in Education Department of any degree college or University.

- (3) District (Tribal) Research Officer in the pay scale of Rs. 650-30-740-35-EB-35-880-40-1000-EB-40-1200/- p.m. (one post)

Candidate should be a 2nd Class Master's Degree holder in any one of the following subjects Sociology/Social Work/Political Science/Economics/History/Education or Philosophy with Psychology and Mental Measurement as subject of study plus research experience of about 3 years. Working knowledge of Mizo language will be essential.

- (4) **Youth Welfare Officer in the pay scale of Rs. 650-30-740-35-810-EB-35-880-40-1000-EB-40-1200/- p. m.**

Candidates should be at least a Graduate in Physical Education or a Graduate with a Diploma in Physical Education from a recognised Institution plus 3 years experience of Physical Education Administration in any recognised Institution.
